

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: that we, whose names are subscribed hereto do, understand in pursuance of the general corporation laws of the State of Idaho, and all amendments thereto, hereby organize, constitute, and associate ourselves and such other persons, as may hereafter become associated with us, into a body politic and corporate, and to that end, execute the following, when duly executed, legally filed and recorded, and certified, as required by the laws of the State of Idaho, shall constitute the Articles of Incorporation of NORTHWESTERN LIQUOR ASSOCIATION, and we do hereby certify, set forth, and declare as follows:

First.

That the name of this corporation shall be NORTHWESTERN LIQUOR ASSOCIATION.

Second.

That the purposes and objects for which this corporation is organized are:

- A. To buy, purchase, take over, carry on, maintain and extend the business of Leo P. Grunbaum.
- B. To engage in a general wholesale and retail, mercantile, manufacturing, producing and distilling business.
- C. To buy, sell, mortgage and deal in stocks ~~or~~ merchandise and mercantile business of all kinds.
- D. To build, operate and run railroads, railway lines, ~~street~~ railroads and to acquire rights of way therefore, to locate power ~~sites~~ and to acquire the same in all ways and to manufacture produce, buy, sell and deal in electric and other motive light and heating powers; to engage in general banking and brokerage business.

E. To acquire by purchase or otherwise real and personal property and the good will rights and assets of all kinds, under such terms and conditions as may be deemed advisable, of any person, firm, corporation, association, or partnership and to pay for the same in cash, stock, bonds or other securities of this corporation, and to sell, mortgage and hypothecate and deal in real and personal property of every kind and description.

F. To borrow money, to mortgage and pledge the property and assets of this corporation, to issue bonds, debentures, or obligations of this corporation from time to time, for any of the purposes and objects of this corporation, and to secure the same by mortgages, deeds of trust, pledges, or liens, on any or all the rights and properties of this corporation wheresoever situated, and to sell or otherwise dispose of said bonds, debentures, and obligations in such manner and upon such terms as the Board of Directors may deem proper.

G. To hold, take, purchase, acquire, to sell, mortgage, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock, bonds and obligations of any corporation organized under the laws of any state in the United States, or any foreign country.

H. To engage in mining and irrigation business, and to buy, sell, deal in, run, operate and maintain mines and mining ranches, water rights, irrigation projects, hotels, boarding houses, restaurants, taverns and inns.

I. To do everything necessary, suitable, convenient, proper or essential for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any one or more of the objects herein enumerated or incidental to the powers herein named, or which shall at any time appear conducive to or expedient for the protection or benefit of the corporation, and this to the same extent and as fully as natural persons might or could do.

And to do all of the above enumerated things in any state or territory of these United States and in foreign countries.

Third.

That the place where the principal business of the corporation is to be transacted, and its principal office located shall be Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho.

Fourth.

That the corporate existence of this corporation shall be limited to a term of fifty years from the date of its incorporation.

Fifth.

That the corporate powers, and the affairs and management of the business of this corporation shall be vested in a Board of Three Directors.

Sixth.

That the amount of the authorized Capital Stock of this corporation shall be One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000), divided into Two Hundred (200) shares of the par value of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) per share.

Seven.

That the amount of the Capital Stock which has been actually subscribed is (\$100,000) One Hundred Thousand Dollars, and the number of shares and the name of each subscriber thereto is as follows:
