BE IT RESOLVED:



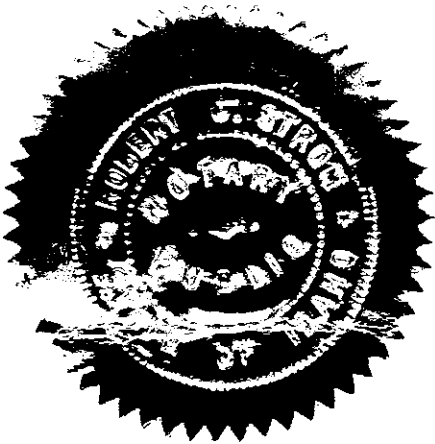
