AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

IDA-OBS GRIZZLY ASSOCIATION, INC.

GEORGE NEAL, President, and LOV CORBRIDGE, Secretary, of the
IDA-OBS GRIZZLY ASSOCIATION, INC. respectfully show that:

1. The above named corporation was organized on February 5, 1887.
2. The above named corporation upon the proposal of its Board of Directors by resolution duly adopted by said Board of Directors setting forth the proposed amendments and directing that the same be submitted to a vote of the members entitled to vote in respect thereof at a designated meeting of such members and upon the adoption thereof by said members at said meeting as provided by law and as hereinafter more specifically set out, does hereby amend its Article 2 and Article 5 to read as follows:

Articles of Amendment of its Articles of Incorporation

3. Article II

The purpose or purposes for which said association is formed are:

- (a) to engage in the business of providing by purchase, lease or otherwise, lands for grazing purposes in the State of Idaho or elsewhere for the use and benefit of its members and not for the purpose of direct gain to the association itself.
- (b) to hold, purchase, acquire, lease and convey real and personal estate; to borrow money for the use and needs of the Association; and to pledge and/or mortgage real, personal and intangible property of said Association as security itself.

Article V

Section 1. The authorized capital stock of the Association shall be 1000 shares of assessable common stock having a \$2.50 per value, which may be issued by the Association to the incorporators and to eligible and approved natural persons for such consideration as may be fixed from time to time by the Board of Directors. The aggregate par value of the authorized capital stock is \$2,500.00. All profits from operations earned by the Association will be distributed to the shareholders.

The above amendment was adopted in the following manner and by the following vote, that is to say:

The Board of Directors of said corporation, at a duly called meeting of said Board held on October 10, 1886, at Nampa City, Idaho, adopted the following resolution of articles of amendment of the articles of incorporation of said corporation.

Resolved, that Article 5 of the Articles of Incorporation of
IDA-UTE GRIZING ASSOCIATION, INC. be amended by striking from Paragraph (a) the words, "and recreational" and by striking from subparagraph (b) in its entirety and by striking the word "(c)" and inserting therefor the word "(b)"; and by striking from Article 5, Section 1, the words "No dividends of any kind shall ever be declared or paid to the shareholders, except upon liquidation of the Association", and by inserting therein the words "All profits from operations earned by the Association will be distributed to the shareholders".

Be it further resolved, that this proposed amendment be submitted to a vote of the members entitled to vote thereon at a special meeting, to be held on the 16th day of October, 1870, at Malad City, Idaho, and the secretary is hereby directed to give notice thereof as required by law.

At the members' meeting the members entitled to vote in respect of said amendments to the articles of incorporation, upon the call and notice required by law, did adopt the above amendment by the affirmative vote of the holders of at least a majority of the members entitled to vote thereon.


