ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

EVERGREEN LODGE No. 124, INDEPENDENT ORDER of ODD FELLOWS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That on the First day of March, 1966, at their Lodge Room in the City of Potlatch, County of Latah, State of Idaho, a meeting of the members of Evergreen Lodge No. 124, Independent Order of Odd Fellows, was held for the purpose of associating themselves together and forming a Corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and We do hereby certify:

I

That the name of this Corporation is EVERGREEN LODGE No. 124, INDEPENDENT ORDER of ODD FELLOWS, Inc.; and the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be in the City of POTLATCH, County of LATAH, State of IDAHO.

II

That the purposes for which it is formed are for Mutual benefit and to promulgate the principles of ODD FELLOWSHIP in accordance with, and under, and subject to the jurisdiction of the SOVEREIGN GRAND LODGE of the INDEPENDENT ORDER of ODD FELLOWS of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA , and the GRAND LODGE of the INDEPENDENT ORDER of ODD FELLOWS of the State of IDAHO.
