

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CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
OF
ADJUSTORS CORPORATION OF AMERICA, INC.

UNDER SECTION 402 OF THE
BUSINESS CORPORATION LAW

I, the undersigned, being over the age of 21 years, for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to Section 402 of the Business Corporation Law of New York, do hereby certify:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is:

ADJUSTORS CORPORATION OF AMERICA, INC.

SECOND: The purposes for which it is formed are:

To act as representative and agent of and for, and in any lawful manner for and on behalf of persons, firms, associations and corporations desiring to purchase, contract for or obtain insurance or reinsurance protection of any kind character whatsoever; to act as representative and broker for and on behalf of persons, firms, associations and corporations desiring to purchase, contract for or obtain insurance or reinsurance protection of any kind or character whatsoever. In furtherance of its corporate purposes, the corporation shall have all of the powers enumerated in Section 202 of the Business

4796447

Corporation Law of the State of New York.

That in addition to the above primary purposes, the corporation shall have the further general purposes and powers as follows:

To examine into, investigate and evaluate all kinds and types of products.

To examine into, investigate and evaluate claims and losses, and to perform and conduct loss adjustments, inspections, consultant services, and any and all other services pertaining thereto and in connection therewith.

To act as an intermediary between insurance companies of any kind or class; to act as an agent in obtaining reinsurance for insurance companies; to act as an underwriting manager for reinsurance operations, and to perform any and all acts in connection with and incident to the foregoing function.

To generally act as agent and representative of and for, and in any lawful manner for and on behalf of insureds, insurers and reinsurers, in any and all things which now and hereafter may lawfully be done by persons, firms or corporations lawfully engaged in business as insurance agents, insurance brokers or loss adjusters.

To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, hold, improve, sell, lease, mortgage and generally deal in lands and buildings and interests therein.

To act as principal, agent, partner, joint venturer or in any other legal capacity in any transaction.

To acquire and pay for in cash, stock or bonds of this corporation or otherwise, the good will, rights, assets and property and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the obligations or liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation.

To acquire, subscribe for, hold, own, pledge and otherwise dispose of and vote shares of stock, bonds and securities of any other corporation, domestic or foreign.

To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind and description with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, county, state, body, politic or government or colony or dependency thereof, conducive to the attainment of any of the objects or purposes of the corporation.

To borrow money and issue bonds, debentures, notes and evidence of indebtedness and to secure the payment or performance of its obligations by mortgage, deed of trust, pledge or otherwise.

To purchase, hold, sell and transfer the shares of its own capital stock so far as may be permitted by the laws of the State of New York.

To have one or more offices within or without the State of New York, to carry on all or any of its operations and business and, without restriction or limit as to amount, to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, own, mortgage, sell, convey or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every class and description in any of the States, districts, territories of the United States, and in any and all foreign countries, subject to the laws

of such state, district, territory, colony or country.

The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the corporation.

In general, to carry on any other business in connection with the foregoing, and to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the State of New York upon corporations formed under the laws of the State of New York.

THIRD: The office of the corporation is to be located in the City, County and State of New York.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is Two-Hundred-Fifty (250) shares without par value.

FIFTH: The Secretary of State is designated as the agent of the corporation upon whom process against the corporation may be served. The post office address to which the Secretary of State shall mail a copy of any process against the corporation served upon him is c/o Kroll, Killarney, Pomerantz and Cameron, 500 Fifth Avenue, New York 10110.

SIXTH: The accounting period which the corporation intends to establish as its first calendar or fiscal year for reporting the franchise tax on business corporations imposed by Article 9A of the Tax Law is the period ending December 31.


