



CHARTER

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, Ellis E. Dunn, Ernest C. Dunn, Sam Houston and M. L. Stalls, citizens of Dallas County, Texas, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Texas, do hereby form and incorporate ourselves into a voluntary association under the terms and conditions hereinafter set out:

I.

NAME. The name of this corporation is DUNN BROS., INC.

II.

PURPOSE. The purpose for which it is formed is to transport goods, wares and merchandise, or any valuable thing.

III.

PLACE OF BUSINESS. The place where the business of Dunn Bros., Inc. is to be transacted is at Dallas, Texas, and wherever the corporation can carry out its purpose, and its principal place of business is to be in Dallas, in Dallas County, Texas.

IV.

TERM. The term for which it is to exist is fifty years.

V.

DIRECTORS. The number of directors will be such as may be permitted by law and determined by the stockholders from time to time, but not less than three.

Until otherwise provided, the number of directors shall be three. Their names and post office addresses are as follows:


