One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-nine** and will be / is duly recorded on ~~Film No.~~ **microfilm** Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **Fifty years** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Tetonis, Idaho** in the County of **Teton** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of
TETON VALLEY SADDLE CLUB, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we the undersigned, all of whom are bona fide residents of the State of Idaho and citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho:

We do hereby certify in writing the following:

1

(a) To unite fraternally and for mutual benefit, improvement and association loyal American citizens of sound body and health, of good moral character and of reasonable desire and ambition to improve themselves and help others.

(b) To foster and cultivate the social, educational and recreational interests of the members; to promote and forward the general welfare of the members; and to promote rodeo recreation and entertainment to Teton Valley.

(c) To develop sportsmanship, fair play and brotherhood among its members.

(d) To purchase, lease, hold and own such personal and real property as deemed necessary to carry out the affairs and conduct of the corporation; and to construct, purchase, lease and maintain such buildings as are necessary in pursuance of the purposes of said corporation.

That pursuant to Notice by publication and by posting for the calling of an election of officers and directors, the majority of the 49 registered members met on June 11th, 1969 at the hour of 8:00 P.M. at Teton, Idaho and chose the officers and directors as hereinafter set forth.

The name of the said corporation shall be known as TETON VALLEY SADDLE CLUB, INC. The location of said corporation shall be in the County of Teton, State of Idaho; and the post office address at Teton, Idaho.

The corporation shall be nonstock, and no dividends or pecuniary benefits or profits shall be declared to the members thereof.

The period of existence and the duration of the life of this corporation shall be fifty years.

VI

The officers of this association shall consist of a president, vice-president, secretary-treasurer.
