Article VIII Liability of Stockholders.

The private property of the stockholders shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts.

Article X Cumulative Voting

In all elections for Directors, shareholders shall be permitted to cumulate their votes. In such elections, shareholders shall have a number of votes equal to the number of shares of stock registered in the shareholder's name on the books of the corporation, multiplied by the number of Directors to be elected.

Article XI Directors

The business of the Corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors, each of whom shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age. The number of directors of the Corporation shall be set forth in the Bylaws and may be altered from time to time by amendment of the Bylaws in a manner not prohibited by law. Until so changed, the number of directors shall be one (1). Directors do not need to be shareholders of the Corporation. The initial board of directors, who shall serve until the first annual meeting of shareholders, or until their successors are elected and qualified, shall consist of one (1) director, Richard Jonathan Hernandez, 300 East 38th, Boise, ID 83714.

Article XII Elimination of Personal Liability of Directors

The directors of this Corporation are not liable to the Corporation or to its shareholders for monetary damages for any action taken, or failure to take any action, as a director, except liability for the following:

- 1. The amount of financial benefit received by a director to which he or she is not entitled;
- 2. An intentional infliction of harm on the Corporation or the shareholders;
- 3. A violation of Idaho Code Section 30-1-833; or
- 4. An intentional violation of criminal law

Article XIII Indemnification of Directors and Officers

The Corporation shall indemnify and hold harmless each director for liability, as defined in Idaho Code Section 30-1-850(5), to any person for any action taken, or any failure to take any action, as a director, except for:

- 1. Receipt of a financial benefit to which he or she is not entitled;
- 2. An intentional infliction of harm on the Corporation or the shareholders;
- 3. A violation of Idaho Code Section 30-1-833; or
- 4. An intentional violation of criminal law.
