

DECREM.

Now on this day comes A.H.Dugger, as President, C.A. Groshans as Vice President, Charles E. Brush as Secretary and Treasurer, J. T. Williamson, W.W. Chicken and G. H. Hendershott, members of the Executive Committee of the General Conference of the Church of God and submit to the Court a petition praying that Arcitles No. 3 and No. 5 of the Articles of Association of said Corporation be smended and that a pro forma decree issue therefor, in manner provided by law and it appearing to the court that said petition has remained on file in the Clerk's office of this county for at least three days since same was first presented to this court, and the court having duly examined the same finds that the General Conference of the Church of God was duly organized by the proforma decree of this court granted at the December term thereof for the year 1899 and that thereafter Alexander A.Lesuer, Cocretary of the State of Missouri, issued a Charter to said Corporation under date of December 26th, 1899, and which said Articles of Association were duly recorded in corporation Book No.I at page ____ of the corporation records of Gentry County, Missouri.

The court further finds that at the annual meeting of the General Conference of the Church of God held at Stanberry, Missouri on the 16th day of August 1929 Article No. 3 of said Articles of Association was amended by said Association so that said Article No. 3 shall read as follows:

ARTICLE No. 3

"The officers of this Association shall be Fresident,
Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer and an Executive
Committee of the General Conference consisting of Five members,
to be elected at the biennial conference and all of whom shall
receive no salary for their services."

of the General Conference of the Church of God held at Stanberry, Missouri, on the 6th day of March 1900 Article No. 5 of said original articles of incorporation was amended and now Article No. 5 passed in lieu thereof and that thereafter said Article 5 was further amended at a meeting of the General Conference held at Stanberry, Missouri on August 16th, 1929 and which said Article No. 5 now reads as follows:

ARTICLE HO. 5

"The business of the Association shall be managed by the President, Vice-President, and an Executive Committee of the General Conference of the Church of God, when Conference is not convened. The Secretary and Treasurer shall be the Secretary of the General Board but shall not be a voting member. In case of the death of resignation of any officer of this Association his successor shall be appointed by the remaining officers, who shall hold his office until the next general election. The members of this Association shall have the right to exend this Constitution not inconsistent with the Laws under which they are organized."

The Court being duly advised in the premises, both now consider, adjudge and determine that the proposed amendments as herein set out are germane to said Charter heretofere issued to The General Conference of the Church of God and that said Articles as amended are not inconsistent with the laws of the State of Missouri and that same come directlywithin the purview of Article II of Chapter 90 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri for the year 1919 and are not inconsistent with the Constitution

and Laws of the United States or the State of Missouri.

Therefore it is ordered, adjudged and decreed
by the court that said Article 3 and said Article of the

are hereby amended and shall be as hereinbefore setout.

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT WITHIN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF GENTRY.

Your Petitioners, the undersigned, holding offices, respectively of President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer and three members of the Executive Committee of the General Conference of the Church of God respectfully represent that they, in connection with others, have associated themselves together, by Articles of Agreement, in writing, as an association for benevolent and religious purposes under the name of The General Conference of the Church of God; that articles of association by pro forma decree were duly granted to said organization by this court at the December Term 1899 thereof and that Alexander A. Lesuer, Secretary of the State of Missouri issued said Charter under date of December 26th, 1899, which said Articles of Association wasseduly recorded in Corporation Book I at page ______ of the corporation records of Gentry County, Missouri.

Your Petitioners further state that at the annual meeting of the General Conference of the Church of God held at Stanberry, Missouri on the 6th day of March 1900 Article 5 of said original Articles of Incorporation was amended and a new Article 5 passed in lieu thereof and thereafter said Article 5 was further amended at a meeting of the General Conference held at Stanberry, Missouri, on August 16th, 1929, and which now is as follows:

ARTICLE 5.

"The business of the Association shall be managed by the President, Vice-President and an Executive Committee of the General Conference of the Church of God, when Conference is not convened. The Secretary and Treasurer shall be the Secretary of the General Board but shall not be a voting member. In case of the death of resignation of the remaining officers, who shall hold his office until the next general election. The members of this Association shall have the right to amend this Constitution not inconsistent with the Laws under which they are organized."

Your Petitioners further state that at a meeting of the General Conference of the Church of God held at Stanberry, Missouri on the 16th day of August 1929 Article 3 of said Articles of Association and said Article 3 of said original Articles was repealed and said new Article 3 enacted in lieu thereof, which said Article 3 as adopted on the date last mentioned is as follows:

ARTICLE 3.

"The officers of this Association shall be President, Vice-President, Seffretary and Treasurer and an Executive Committee of the General Conference consisting of five members, to be elected at the biennial conference and all of whom shall receive no salary for their services."

WHEREFORE Your Petitioners pray that a pro forma decree may be granted authorizing the amendments herein proposed and which said amendments are germane to said Charter heretofore issued and are not inconsistent with the Laws of the State of Missouri, all in pursuance of the Statutes that which such cases made and provided.


ARTICLE 3.

"The business of the Association shall be managed by the Executive Board (or Board of Control) when conference is not convened and said Executive Board shall consist of twelve men. The term of office shall be six years, except that at the beginning of the operation of the plan, four shall be chosen for six years, and four for four years, and four for two years. Thereafter four shall be chosen at each biennial session of the Conference. The officers of the Association shall be Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer to be elected every two years by a majority vote of the Executive Board."

Adams, as Secretary and Otto Haeber, as Treasurer of the General Conference of the Church of God and submit to the Court a petition praying that Articles No. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Articles of Association of said Corporation be amended and that a pro forma decree issue therefor, in manner provided by law and it appearing to the Court that said petition has remained on file in the Clerk's office of this County for at least three days same was first presented to this Court, and the Court having duly examined the same finds that the General Conference of the Church of God was duly organized by the pro forma decree of this court granted at the December term thereof for the year 1899 and that thereafter Alexander A. Lesuer, Secretary of the State of Missouri, issued a Charter to said Corporation under date of December 26th, 1899, and which said Articles of Association were duly recorded in corporation book I at page 106 of the corporation records of Gentry County, Missouri; that amendments to the Articles of Association by pro forma decree were granted to said organization by this court at the September term 1930 thereof and that Charles U. Becker, Secretary of the State of Missouri, issued said amendments to the Articles of Association under date of October 2nd, 1930, which amendments were duly recorded in Corporation Book II at page 200 of the corporation records of Gentry County, Missouri.

The Court further finds that at a meeting of the General Conference of the Church of God held at Stanberry,

amendments as herein set out are germane to said Charter heretofore issued to The General Conference of the Church of God and that said Articles as amended are not inconsistent with the laws of the State of Missouri and that same come directly within the purview of Article 10 of Chapter 33 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri for the year 1939 and are not inconsistent with the Constitution and Laws of the United States or the State of Missouri.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that said Articles 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 of the General Conference of the Church of God be and the same are hereby amended and shall be as hereinbefore set out.
