

A R T I C E S O F I N C O R P O R A T I O N .

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, a majority of whom are resident free-holders of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a Corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho.

1. The name of this said Corporation shall be the W.A. Hyde Company, Limited.

2. The purpose for which this corporation is formed is to conduct a general mercantile and manufacturing business and to deal in real estate by purchasing, selling, exchanging etc.

3. The place where the principal business of this corporation shall be carried on is at Downey, Bannock County, Idaho.

4. The term for which it is to exist shall be fifty years.
