ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION

OF

KIDS' CASTLE PARENT COOPERATIVE PRESCHOOL, INCORPORATED

KNOW ALL MEN AND WOMEN BY THESE PRESENT:

That the undersigned, Mary Thorburn-Henry, Nanette Swendig, Elizabeth Brinton and Jeri Kilburg, each being of full age, have associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit educational and charitable corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and pursuance thereof do hereby sign and acknowledge the following Articles of Incorporation in triplicate originals, and do state as follows:

I

The the corporate name of this corporation shall be KIDS' CASTLE PARENT COOPERATIVE PRESCHOOL, INCORPORATED.

ΙI

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

To establish, organize, continue, equip, own, operate, manage, control, maintain, carry on, conduct and provide educational experiences for preschool age children and their families, individually and in groups, when feasible; to own, lease, rent, buy, sell and mortgage real and personal property necessary or desirable for fulfillment of these purposes and to receive contributions from private and public sources to carry out these purposes.

That this corporation shall continue perpetually.

IV

That the address of the registered office of this corporation shall be 1320 Coeur d'Alene Avenue, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, Kootenai County, and that the name of the registered agent is Mary Thorburn-Henry.

V

That the membership of the corporation shall be open to all members meeting the membership requirements set forth in the By-Laws; that no stock shall be issued; and that each member shall have equal voting rights and privileges.

VI

That the number of directors of this corporation shall be not less than four nor more then ten, qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of meeting, and the powers and duties of directors shall be such as are prescribed by the By-Laws of this corporation; that the names and addresses of the first directors who shall hold office and manage the affairs of the corporation until May 31, 1992, are as follows:

That authority to make By-Laws for this corporation is hereby expressly vested, in the School Board of this corporation, subject to the powers of the members to change or repeal such By-Laws.

IX

That these Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a majority vote of all of the members cast at a meeting called for that purpose or by mail.

That upon dissolution of this corporation, the net assets and property of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed by the federal government for a public purpose. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the Court of Common Pleas Kootenai County Idaho, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. The private property of the Directors or Board Members of this Corporation shall not be liable for the debts of the Corporation.
