The membership of the Friends of the Farm, Inc, a non-profit corporation incorporated in the state of Idaho, having been notified 30 days in advance, met on September 29, 1981, and a quorum being present, resolved by a majority vote of those members entitled to vote that;

Because the Friends of the Farm, Inc. no longer is able to usefully assist the University of Idaho Museum in establishing an open area museum;

That the Friends of the Farm, Inc. is hereby dissolved;

That all assets of the Friends of the Farm, Inc., shall be and is hereby transferred to the University of Idaho Museum, a non-profit entity; and that all documents, reports, maps, photos, oral history tapes and similar items shall be deposited in the Special Collections section of the University of Idaho library, a non-profit entity, for public use.
