ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT:

That, we the undersigned citizens of the United States of America each over the age of twnety-one years, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby make, sign and acknowledge and file the said Articles of Incorporation as follows:

I.

That the name and style of said corporation shall be as follows: BOB NELSON FORD, Inc.

II.

That the location and post office address of said corporation shall be as follows: 806 Bank Street, Wallace, Idaho.

III.

The purpose for which said corporation is incorporated is to enter into the general automobile business and real estate business and for businessess which are relative to those purposes herein above set out.

IV.

The corporation shall purchase or otherwise acquire, own, hold, lease sell, eschange, assign, transfer, mortgage, hypothecate or in anywise dispose of, and to invest, trade and deal in all forms and types of automobiles and real estate.

V.

The corporation may enter into any kind of contract or agreement, cooperative or profit sharing plan with its officers or employees that the corporation may deem advantageous or expedient or otherwise to reward or pay such person or persons for their services and as the directors may deem fit and proper.

VI.

The corporation may build houses, or other buildings of every kind, character or description, and either for sale or for lease, and upon contract, mortgage or otherwise; and to lay out,

subdivide and plat tracts of land and to sell the same; and to improve all of the lands so purchased and to oil, grade and improve the street, alleys and parks so constructed and to do all other matters and things appertaining to such business.

VII.

The corporation may purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, in whole or in part, the business, goodwill, rights, franchise and property of every kind, and to undertake the whole or any part of the assets or liabilities, of any person, firm or corporation engaged in or authorized to conduct any business similar to any business authorized to be conducted by this corporation, or owning property necessary or suitable for its purpose, and may pay for the same in cash, in stock of the company, or otherwise, and to hold or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the business or property so acquired, and to exercise all the powers necessary or incidental to the conduct of such business.

VIII.

The corporation may lend money and may negotiate and make loans, either on it own account or as a broker.

IX.

This corporation may borrow, issue bonds, debentures, notes or other obligations of this corporation from time to time, for any of the objects and purposes of this corporation, and to mortgage pledge, hypothecate and/or convey in trust, any or all of its property to secure the payment thereof.

χ.

This corporation may discount and negotiate promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, and other evidences of debt, and to collect for other money due them on notes, checks, drafts bills of exchange, and other evidences of indebtednesses.

XI.

The corporation may enter, into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and for any lawful purpose, with limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, state or government, or any of their subdivisions.

This corporation may engage in and conduct any and all kinds of manufacturing businesses which are in line with the purposes for which this corporation was incorporated.

XIII.

The corporation may do any and all such other acts, things business or businesses in any manner connected with or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary to any of the objects hereinabove enumerated, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation; and in carrying on its purposes or for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its business to do any and all acts and things, and to exercise any and all other powers, which a natural person could do or exercise, and which now or hereafter may be authorized by law to do.

XIV.

The corporation, along with the purposes hereinabove set forth shall be authorized and empowered to sell boats, motors for boats, and such other items which shall be used in their operation.

XV.

That the county in the State of Idaho where the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is to be located is SHOSHONE COUNTY, Idaho.

XVI.

The term and existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

XVII.

This corporation is hereby incorporated for the sum of \$75,000.00 and the stock shall be divided into 750 shares of the par value of \$100.00 per share.

The number of said directors for the corporation shall be five in number.
