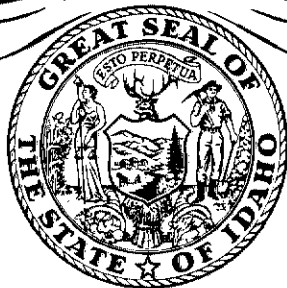

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

WALLY YORK & SON, INC.

WE, The undersigned, being natural persons, over the age of 21 years, and citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify as follows, to-wit:

ARTICLE I

NAME: The name of this corporation shall be WALLY YORK & SON, INC.

ARTICLE II.

PURPOSES: The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

(a) To engage in the general business of providing recreational hunting, fishing, packing, sightseeing, and tours in areas in Idaho County Idaho.

(b) To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of, convey, mortgage or lease, real and personal property; to dispose, sell, lease, assign, transfer, mortgage or convey any rights, permits, priveleges, franchises, real or personal property of the corporation, other than its franchise of being a corporation, and to purchase, guarantee, take, receive, subscribe for or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares or other interests in, or obligations of other domestic or foreign corporations, associations, partnerships, or individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States, or any other government, state, territory, governmental district or municipality, or of any instru-

mentality thereof.

(c) To purchase, hold, sell, and reissue the shares of its own capital stock.

(d) To borrow or loan money for any purpose of this corporation without limit as to the amount, to issue bonds, debentures, notes or other evidence of indebtedness, secured or unsecured of this corporation for moneys so borrowed, or for the payment of the property acquired, and to do all those things authorized by the laws of the State of Idaho.

(e) To carry out all or any part of the foregoing objects or purposes, either alone or in conjunction with any person or corporation.

(f) The objects so specified herein shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any clause or paragraph. The objects, purposes and powers specified in each clause or paragraph in these Articles shall be regarded as independent objects, purposes and powers.

ARTICLE III.

DURATION: The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

REGISTERED OFFICE: The principal place of business and the registered office of this corporation shall be P.O. Box 457, Elk City, Idaho County Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

STOCK: This corporation is authorized to issue one class of shares of stock, nonassessable, the total number of which shall be 500 shares, with a par value of One Hundred Dollars per share, for a total aggregate of Fifty Thousand Dollars, which stock shall

be issued by the corporation from time to time as determined by the Board of Directors thereof.

ARTICLE VI.

DIRECTORS: The directors of the corporation shall be not less than three, nor more than five, as may be provided in the By-laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII.
