ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned natural person of the age of eighteen (18) years or more, acting as incorporator under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is RIVER ADVENTURE, INC. and its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II

ARTICLE III
