

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

JUVENILE JUSTICE ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned, being a natural person over the age of eighteen (18) years and a citizen of the United States, and acting as incorporator of a Non-Profit corporation under the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act does hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

ARTICLE II

The specific and primary purpose for which this corporation is formed is to provide, without charge, legal education, advice, counsel, representation and general assistance in the reform of the law regarding the rights of minors, particularly indigent minors, to the full and equal protection of the laws; and, to assist in the evaluation, encouragement, education and development of the promotion of the rights of minors. To conduct any lawful business to further the purposes specified above.

ARTICLE III

- 1. In order to accomplish the foregoing charitable purposes, the corporation shall have the following powers:
 - A. To sue and be sued;
 - B. To buy, lease, rent, or otherwise acquire, hold or use, own, enjoy, sell, exchange, lease as lessor, mortgage, deed in trust, pledge, encumber, transfer on trust or otherwise dispose of any all kinds of property, whether real, personal or mixed, and to receive property by devise or bequest;
 - C. To borrow money and to contract debts, to issue bonds, notes, and other evidences of indebtedness, and to secure them by any or all of the property of this corporation, or to issue them unsecured;
 - D. To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose and without limit on amount with any person, firm or corporation; and
 - E. To have and to exercise all the powers conferred by the Idaho General Nonprofit Corporation Law on nonprofit corporation law, as the law is now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended.
 - F. To conduct any lawful business to further the specified purposes of the Corporation.
- 2. Notwithstanding any of the above statements of purpose and powers, this corporation shall not engage in activities that in

themselves are not in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II herein, and nothing contained in the foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed to authorize this corporation to carry on any activities for the profit of its members or to distribute any gains, profits or dividends to any of its members.

3. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation is organized under the General Nonprofit Corporation Act of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V

The principal office of this corporation for transaction of business is to be located in the City and County of Twin Falls, Idaho, at 330 8th Avenue North, P.O. Box 934 Twin Falls, Idaho and the initial registered agent and incorporator shall be Joseph S. Stanzak whose address is 330 8th Avenue North, P.O. Box 934 Twin Falls, Idaho 83303.

ARTICLE VI

ARTICLE VII

The number and qualifications of members of the corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the voting and other rights and privileges of members and their liability for dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be as set forth in the bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII

This corporation is not organized, nor shall it be operated, for pecuniary gain or profit, and it does not contemplate the distribution of gain, profits of dividends to its members and is organized solely for non-profit purposes. The property, assets, profits and net income of this corporation shall never inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member or to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual except that the corporation may pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and make payments and distribution in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles. On the dissolution or winding up of this corporation any assets remaining after payment of all liabilities shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation that is organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, educational and/or literary purposes and that has established its tax exempt status under

Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

If this corporation holds any assets in trust, they shall be disposed of in such a manner as may be directed by judgment of the District Court in the county in which this corporation's principal office is located, on petition by the attorney general or by any person concerned in the liquidation.

ARTICLE IX

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE X

The corporation shall not discriminate against any person nor shall membership be granted, denied or revoked on account of race, color, sex, disability, religion or national origin.
