ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
IDA-WOOD INDUSTRIES, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify;

I.

That the corporate name of this organization shall be

IDA-WOOD INDUSTRIES, INC.

II.

The principle place of business for said corporation shall be the city of Athol, Kootenai County, State of Idaho.

III.

That the purposes and objectives for which said corporation is formed are as follows:

1. To form a private profit-making corporation.
2. To purchase, locate, lease, build, or otherwise acquire lands, and buildings, offices, shops and any other buildings, equipment or real properties necessary or desirable for the accomplishment, location and housing of the operations of this corporation.
3. To conduct a general fabricating and construction business, including but not limited to the pre-fabrication of building components and other structures using wood and all other materials common to this industry.
4. To market all products or services of the corporation..
5. To Buy, sell, exchange, encumber, lease or transfer, or any transaction with real or personal property which will forward the business of the corporation.
6. To hire and retain personnel and employees necessary for the carrying out of the operations of the corporation.

7. To take, exchange, buy, hold, purchase, or otherwise acquire and to sell, assign, pledge, and otherwise dispose of mortgages and all other liens on property, real, personal, or mixed, and also deal in bonds, notes, stocks, warehouse receipts, warrants and any and every kind of promissory papers and other evidences of debt.

8. To subscribe for, acquire, by purchase, or otherwise to own, hold, sell assign and transfer shares of the capital stock of any corporation by its authorized officer or proxy, and vote such shares at any stockholder's meeting of the corporation whose shares are so held; also to acquire by purchase or otherwise, and to own, hold, sell, assign and transfer shares of the capital stock of this corporation.

9. To enter into contracts with private or governmental bodies for the performance of any activity and apply for and hold any necessary licenses from a governmental agency necessary for the performance of the business of the company.

IV.

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

V.

To do each, and all of said things for itself and in its corporate name, and as agent for any reason, firm or corporation, and to do any and every act or thing incident to all of the foregoing mentioned powers, and to do any and all of said things in the State of Idaho, and every state and territory of the United States and in any foreign country.

VI.

The capital stock of this corporation shall be \$50,000.00 divided into 500,000 shares of the par value of \$0.10 per share.

VII.

The corporate Board of Directors shall consist of no more than 20, nor less than 3 stockholders to be elected by the stockholders at their organizational meeting and thereafter at the annual stockholders meeting.
