I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State and collector of the annual corporation tax, do hereby certify that

a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho with its principal place of business in Idaho located at Pocatello, Idaho, forfeited on the 30th day of November, 1969, its charter or authority to do business in the State of Idaho, because of failure to file an annual statement and pay the corporation license tax due the State of Idaho for the fiscal year ending June 30th, 1970, as provided by Section 30-608, Idaho Code.
