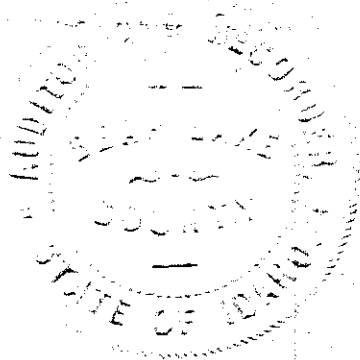

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE SOUTH
FIELD IRRIGATION COMPANY.

First:--- The Name of this Corporation shall be
" The South Field Irrigation Company ".

Second:--- This Corporation is formed for the purpose
of constructing ditches, Dams, Flumes, canals, and water-
ways, for the conveyance of the waters of Paris Creek to,
over and upon the lands of the stockholders of this Corp-
oration, situated in Paris, Bear Lake County, Idaho, and
in the vicinity thereof. Said waters to be used for agric-
ultural and culinary purposes and for propelling machinery.

Third:--- The place where the principal business of
this corporation is to be transacted is Paris, Bear Lake
County, State of Idaho.

Fourth:--- This Corporation is to exist for a period
of Fifty (50) years.

Fifth:--- The Corporate powers of this corporation
shall be vested in a board of five directors , and the
following named persons are appointed for the first year
or until such time as the by-laws adopted by this corp-
oration shall designate for the holding of the next
Annual meeting, at which time their successors shall be
elected, viz:

Edward Painter.

Charles G. Longhurst.

Joseph Nye.

Arthur Hess.

John H. Stocker.

This corporation is one not conducted for revenue or profit, but is
formed solely for the convenience of its various stockholders in the
use by them of the said waters of Paris Creek, for the irrigation of
their lands, and for culinary purposes.

Sixth:--- That the amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be five thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) which shall be divided into Five Hundred (500) shares of Ten Dollars each.

Seventh:--- The amount of the Capital stock actually subscribed is 227 shares, and each of the following named persons has subscribed the amount of stock set opposite his name, to-wit:
