Stopping of Or ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

OAKLEY COMMODITY CORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, citizens and residents of the United States of America, each over the age of 18 years, together with a domestic corporation, do by these presents, voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation, as hereinafter stated, pursuant to and under the laws of the State of Idaho, and do hereby execute and deliver these 11 Articles Of Incorporation for that purpose.

WE HEREBY SET FORTH, DECLARE AND CERTIFY:

ARTICLE I

NAME

This corporation shall be known as "OAKLEY COMMODITY CORPORATION".

ARTICLE II

OBJECTS AND PURPOSES

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- To buy and sell agricultural products, and to arrange (a) for the storage, transportation, and processing of agricultural products, and growing crops, of every kind or nature, and in conjunction therewith to provide storage, transportation, and processing, and to undertake and carry out marketing and other business obligations in connection with the growing, processing, and sale of agricultural crops and products.
- To engage in any commercial, industrial or agri-(b) cultural enterprise, calculated or designed to be profitable to this corporation, and in conformity with the laws of the State of Idaho, or such other place or places and states in which the corporation may, from time to time, conduct its business.
- To purchase, lease, own, sell, mortgage, sublease, and otherwise acquire lands, buildings, easements or property, real and personal, which may be requisite for the purposes of or capable of being conveniently used in connection with any of the objects of this corporation, and to enter into,

1 make, perform, carry out contracts of every sort and kind, with any person, including the right 2 to become a partner or interested in a joint venture, and to acquire and take over the good 3 will, property, rights, franchises, and assets of every kind, and liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation, either wholly or in 4 part, and to pay for the same in cash, stocks, bonds of the corporation, or otherwise. 5 6 To organize or cause to be organized under the (d) laws of any state of the United States, or 7 the District of Columbia, or of any territory, dependency, or possession of the United States, 8 or of any foreign country, a corporation, or corporations for the purpose of transacting, 9 promoting or carrying on any or all of the objects or purposes for which this corporation 10 is organized, and to dissolve, wind up, liquidate, merge, or consolidate any such corporation or 11 corporations, or to cause the same to be dissolved, wound up, liquidated, merged or consolidated. 12 To do all and every thing necessary, suitable, and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any of the objectives, (e) 13 PARSONS, SMITH & STONE LAWYERS BURLEY, IDAHO 14 or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either along or in association with other 15 corporations, firms, or individuals, and to do every other act, or acts, thing, or things, 16 incidental or pertinent to or growing out of, or connected with the foregoing objects or purposes, 17 or any part or parts thereof, provided the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this 18 corporation is organized. 19 The provisions of these Articles shall be construed (f) as purposes and powers, and each as an independent 20 purpose and power in furtherance of, and not in limitation of, the powers which the corporation 21 may have under present or future laws of the State of Idaho, and in such states as the corporation may, from time to time, do business. 22 23 To have and to exercise all rights and powers from (g) time to time granted to a corporation by law. 24 25 ARTICLE III 26 DURATION 27 The term and existence of this corporation shall be 28 perpetual. 29 ARTICLE IV 30 LOCATION OF REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT 31 The location and registered office of this corporation 32 is P. CORPORATE STOCK

The total number of shares of stock which the corporation is authorized to issue is 100 shares of stock with no par value per share.

CHARACTERISTICS OF STOCK

The holders of the common stock are entitled to all dividends declared by the Board of Directors, each stockholder of common stock of record shall be entitled in all meetings of the corporation or in matters requiring a vote, to one (1) vote for each share of stock standing in his name upon the books of the corporation.

The holder of shares of any class in this corporation shall, upon sale by authorization of the corporation, for cash or shares of the same class, have the right, during a reasonable time to be fixed by the Board of Directors, to purchase shares in proportion to their respective holdings of shares of such class, at such price as may be fixed therefore by the Board of Directors, but at not less than par for par value shares.

All stock, when fully paid, shall be non-assessable. The corporation may purchase its own stock.

No sale or transfer of stock may be made without a prior offering in writing to the remaining stockholders in the same proportion as their shareholdings and at the same price, terms and conditions on which the prospective transfer is predicated.

The Directors need not be stockholders of the corporation.
