

APPOINTMENT OF DANIEL MARY GORMAN AS BISHOP OF
THE DIOCESE OF BOISE IN THE STATE OF IDAHO, U.S.A.

Benedict, Bishop, servant of the Servants
of God, to his beloved children, the clergy and
people of the city and diocese of Boise City,
health and apostolic benediction.

In accordance with the advice of our venerable brother cardinals of the Holy Roman Church, we have on this day, by apostolic authority, selected Daniel Mary Gorman, President of the Archdiocesan College of Douai, Procurator Apostolic and Doctor of Canon Law, for your Cathedral Church of Boise City, lately bereft of its chief shepherd, and we appoint him to the office of Bishop and pastor.

We therefore direct that you receive said Bishop-elect, Daniel Mary Gorman, whole-heartedly and with all due honor, yielding cheerful obedience to his salutary counsels and commands, to the end that you may be his devoted children and that he may be to you a father benevolent and kind.

We further desire and command that the official who during the interregnum shall have acted as

administrator of your diocese provide that this document be read publicly from the pulpit of the cathedral church on the first Sunday or holy day of obligation after the bishop takes possession of his see.

Given at St. Peter's in Rome in the year of our Lord nineteen eighteen, on the sixth day of February, in the fourth year of our Pontificate.


