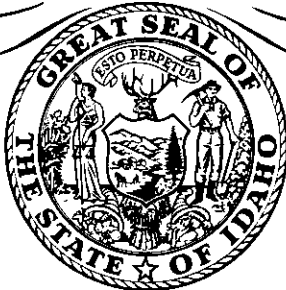

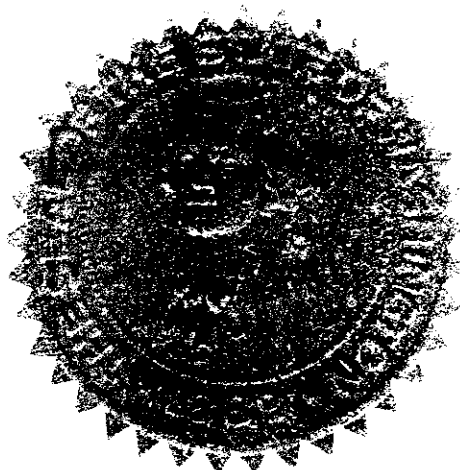

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

FREEWAY REALTY, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, LEO L. KNOWLTON, RICHARD D. TAYLOR and COLIN C. TAYLOR, all being citizens of the United States and residents of the State of Washington, being desirous of forming a corporation for the purposes herein specified, and in conformity with the laws of the State of Washington, do make and subscribe the following Articles of Incorporation in triplicate.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be: FREEWAY REALTY, INC.

ARTICLE II

The period of existence and duration of this corporation shall be fifty (50) years.

ARTICLE III

The principal office of this corporation shall be: 6404 E. Sprague, in the City of Spokane, County of Spokane, State of Washington and the board of directors shall have the right to make By-laws.

ARTICLE IV

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized and the nature of the business to be carried on by it are stated to be as follows, to-wit:

To purchase, lease from others, and otherwise acquire, construct, improve, mortgage, sell, exchange, convey, transfer, lease to others or otherwise dispose of, real or personal property in its own name, in the name of others, on consignment or otherwise.

To create, issue, accept and negotiate bonds and mortgages, bills of exchange, trade acceptances, promissory notes or other obligations or negotiable instruments, and in general to borrow money for any purpose deemed to be beneficial or to the interests of this corporation and to give security therefor and interest thereon in any form.

To finance or loan money or enter into contracts of guaranty for the purpose of financing any business, individual, firm or corporation which might enhance the business or profits of this corporation, and to take security therefor in any form with all rights incidental thereto, and to contract with any individual, firm or corporation in the furnishing of labor, materials or equipment of any kind.

To do or engage in any act or carry on any business enterprise calculated directly or indirectly to further the interests of this corporation which it might be deemed to be profitable, whether herein specifically referred to or not, except such activities as are otherwise limited by law.

To purchase, manufacture, buy, import or otherwise acquire, to repair, remodel, patent, sell, distribute, transport, exchange or deal in at wholesale and/or retail on commission and otherwise, any and all commodities and/or articles of manufactured goods or raw materials and any and all kinds of merchandise and/or accessories or supplies and sundries, hardware tools, building supplies, lumber, cement, cement products, materials of all kinds and machinery, to establish and maintain mills, plants, yards, stores, warehouses and other manufacturing and distributing centers for the manufacture, assembling and distribution of any and every kind of commodity, goods, wares, merchandise or other articles of trade or commerce incidental to or necessary for, or that may be manufactured, sold or distributed to advantage and profit of this

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corporation, to act as agents, brokers or factors on commission or otherwise in any transaction or for any reason in carrying out the purposes of this corporation, to render personal service in any manner and to engage in general construction work and contracting.

To operate the business of the corporation in the State of Washington or any other state or territory of the Union wherever it may be deemed to the best interests of the corporation so to do.

That the corporation shall have the capacity to act possessed by a natural person, that this corporation shall have authority to perform only such acts are necessary and proper to accomplish its purposes and which are not repugnant to law.

ARTICLE V

The amount of paid in capital with which said corporation shall begin is Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE VI

The amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars, consisting of five thousand (5,000) shares of common stock having a par value of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per share.

ARTICLE VII
