We the undersigned, William G. Gare, Robert E. Strahorn Alexander Caldwell, and Hugh C. Wallace, a majority of whom are residents of the State of Colorado, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of creating a corporation under the laws of the State of Colorado, authorizing the formation of corporations for mining, manufacturing, and other industrial pursuits, and in compliance with the provisions of said laws we do hereby state and certify:

First: The corporate name of this company is and shall be "The Idaho and Oregon Land Improvement Company."

Second: The object for which this company is formed is to acquire, hold, improve, sell, lease, and convey real property, to construct street railways, bridges, public water works, irrigating canals, to engage in the manufacture of lumber, brick, and such other articles as may seem desirable in the States of Oregon, and Colorado, and the territories of Utah, Idaho, Washington, Montana, and Wyoming.

Third: The amount of the capital stock of this company is, and shall be Five Thousand (5000) shares of the par value of one Hundred ^{dollars} (\$100) each, making the aggregate sum of five hundred thousand (\$500,000).

Fourth: The existence of the company shall continue for the term of twenty (20) years.

Fifth: The number of directors who shall manage the business affairs of said company is five, which

number may be increased to seven or a larger
vote of the stockholders.

The directors who shall manage the affairs of said
company from the date of this organization for the
first year shall be the following, to wit: William
G. Case, Robert E. Strahorn, Alexander Caldwell,
Hugh B. Wallace, and J. F. Singiser, and there shall
be an annual election for directors on the
Thursday of May of each year thereafter, or on an
other date as the By-Laws may prescribe.

Sixth: The principal office of said company
shall be, and is hereby located in Denver, Colorado,
where the principal business thereof will be trans-
acted with branch offices at Boise City, Idaho,
and Baker City Oregon, and at such other points
as a majority of the Board of Directors may
from time to time agree upon.

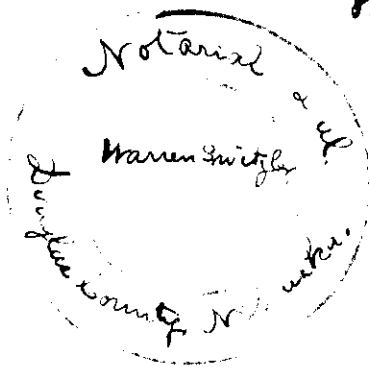

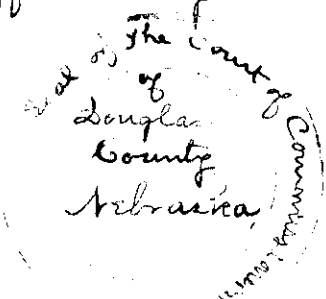
