I, IRA H. MASTERS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

BOISE SOUTHSIDE CHURCH OF THE NAZARENE, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Eighth** day of **February** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-five** and is duly recorded on Film No. **89** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise** in the County of **Ada**, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

I.

That the name of the corporation is and shall forever be the BOISE SOUTHSIDE CHURCH OF THE NAZARENE, INC.

II.

That the principal office for the transaction of the business of this Corporation is at 1325 Euclid Avenue, Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho.

III.

That this corporation is formed for the purposes stated as follows:

- A. Religious and benevolent purposes, and not for pecuniary profit, and particularly for preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and for conducting public worship and charitable and benevolent purposes connected therewith according to the constitution and tenets of the religious denomination known as The Church of the Nazarene.
- B. To acquire by purchase, donation, gift, or otherwise and to hold, use, sell, grant, convey, rent, mortgage or otherwise encumber all such real estate and personal property as may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of carrying into effect heretofore the object mentioned.

IV.

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We hereby certify:

(Organization Meeting.) That a meeting of the worshipers and members of the Church and congregation known as the BOISE SOUTHSIDE CHURCH OF THE NAZARENE, INC. was duly and regularly held on Sunday, the 9th day of January, 1955, at eleven o'clock A. M. in the church building of said church, situated at 1325 Euclid Avenue, Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho, which said church building is the place where said members and congregation statedly meet for public worship; that said meeting was held for the purpose of authorizing the incorporation of said church and for electing four trustees to take charge of the property and estate, both real and personal of said church and congregation, and to transact all affairs relative to said church and its property, which said trustees should become a body corporate, agreeable to and in conformity with the statute in such case made and provided.

(Notice of Meeting.) That due and regular notice, in writing, of the holding of said meeting at the time and place as aforesaid; for authorizing the incorporation and for election of trustees as aforesaid, was given by publication for two successive weeks in the Idaho Daily Statesman, a paper published in the city and county where such church is located and said meeting held; and also by giving notice from the pulpit and by posting notice in a conspicuous place on the building where such election was held for the same length of time.

(Chairman and Secretary.) That at the time and place so designated in said notice, to-wit: on the 9th day of January, 1955, in said church building, a majority of the members and worshipers being present, by a plurality vote, elected Paul R. Weaver as Chairman, and Mrs. W. C. Shoemaker as Secretary, who, together determined the qualifications of the voters present at said meeting,

and received and counted the votes cast at said meeting.

(Trustees) That said voters determined as aforesaid, by a plurality vote, elected the following named persons as the trustees of the Boise Southside Church of the Nazarene, to-wit:

to take charge of the property and temporal affairs of said church.

(Constitution Adopted) That the meeting of January 9, 1955, for the purpose of considering and adopting Articles of Incorporation was held at the time and place fixed by the notice duly and regularly given, to-wit: January 9, 1955, at eleven o'clock A.M., a majority of the members of the church and congregation being present, the meeting was called to order and presided over by Paul R Weaver, who was elected chairman, and Mrs W C Shoemaker, who was elected secretary, said members present, by unanimous vote, adopted the Articles of Incorporation of said Boise Southside Church of the Nazarene as hereto attached.
