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## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned, all of whom are of legal age, residents of the State of Washington, and citizens of the United States, do hereby associate ourselves for the purpose of forming a Corporation and for that purpose execute these Articles of Incorporation, in triplicate originals.

## ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be Postlewait Construction and Rigging Co.

## ARTICLE II

The objects and purposes for which this Corporation is formed are:

- (a) To engage in the construction and rigging business in all of its variations and to acquire, own, operate, lease, and dispose of any property necessary or desirable to carry on such business.
- (b) To engage in the logging business in all its variations and to acquire, own, operate, lease and dispose of any property necessary or desirable in carrying on such business.
- (c) To engage in the business of transporting persons or property for hire by any means of conveyance, as a common carrier, contract carrier, or otherwise, and to acquire, own, operate, lease and dispose of any property necessary or desirable to carry on such business.
- (d) To acquire, own, mortgage, pledge, sell, rent, assign and transfer or otherwise dispose of, to invest, trade, deal in and deal with real or personal property of every class and description.
- (e) To borrow money and pledge its assets as security therefor, and to loan money and obtain from the borrower pledges of the borrowers assets as security therefor.
- (f) To generally engage in any business that a natural person might or could do or perform except such acts which a corporation specifically is forbidden by the laws of the State of Washington to do.

## ARTICLE III

This Corporation shall have a perpetual duration.

#### ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of the Corporation in the State of Washington, shall be North 2611 Adams Street, Spokane, Washington 99205.

#### ARTICLE V

The capital stock of this Corporation shall be \$50,000.00 divided into 50,000 shares of non-assessable common stock, having a par value of \$1.00 per share.

#### ARTICLE VI

The amount of paid in capital with which the Corporation will begin business is \$500.00.

#### ARTICLE VII

The number of Directors of this Corporation shall be three. The names of the first Directors, who shall manage the affairs of the Corporation until the 16th day of January, 1967, or until their successors are elected and qualified and their post office addresses are:

#### ARTICLE VIII

ARTICLE IX

The principal place of business of this Corporation shall be North 2611 Adams Street, Spokane, Washington, 99205, or at any other convenient location in the State of Washington, with such branch offices either within or without the State of Washington as the Directors may designate.

ARTICLE X

The authority to make By-Laws for this Corporation is hereby expressly vested in the Board of Directors of this Corporation, subject to the power of the shareholders to change or repeal such By-Laws.
