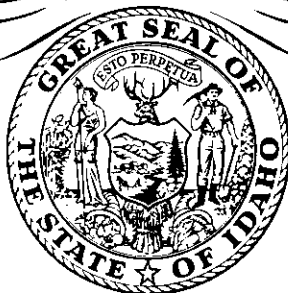

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

LITERARY ENTERPRISES, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned,
being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States of
America, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter
stated, pursuant to the Business Corporation Act of the State of Idaho,
do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

That the name of the corporation shall be: LITERARY ENTERPRISES,
INC.

ARTICLE II

That the purposes for which said corporation shall be formed are:

(a) To engage in and carry on the business of obtaining by
purchase, gifts or otherwise, literary articles, objects of art, pictures
and photographs of all kinds, employing personnel for the purpose of
writing literary articles, stories concerning news events, taking, print-
ing, and producing photographs of all kinds and pictures; obtaining copy-
rights and accepting assignment of copyrights of material subject thereto
of providing scripts, announcements and other materials for broadcast
by radio and television and to do all things relating and incidental to the

matters herewith set forth.

(b) To carry on and conduct business as printers and publishers of journals, magazines, books, newspapers and other literary works and undertakings and also to carry on business as printers, book sellers, book binders, paper makers, stationers, engravers, photographers, photographic printers, stereotypers, electrotypers, mythographers; purchasing, owning and controlling of such rights, franchises and properties as may be considered useful and convenient in the business of selling and disposing of literary news and undertakings and photographic pictures for broadcasting by radio or television or for republication or any other means which may be considered useful and convenient in the business of printing and publication of journals, magazines, books and newspapers.

(c) To purchase, obtain and otherwise acquire franchises, licenses and contracts and to enter into franchise agreements, sales agreements and all other matters relating to the purposes set forth in Paragraph (a) above.

(d) To purchase or otherwise acquire, own, hold, lease, sell, exchange, assign, transfer, mortgage, hypothecate, pledge or otherwise dispose of, to guarantee, and to invest, trade and deal in and with personal property of every class and description.

(e) To purchase or otherwise acquire, own, hold, lease, sell,

exchange, assign, transfer, mortgage, hypothecate or otherwise dispose of, and to invest, trade and deal in and with real property and any and all interests therein.

(f) To enter into any kind of contract or agreement, bonus or profit-sharing plan with its officers and employees that the corporation may deem advantageous or expedient, or otherwise to reward or pay such persons for their services as the directors may deem fitting.

(g) To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, in whole or in part, the business, good will, rights, franchises and property of every kind, and to undertake the whole or any part of the assets or liabilities of any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation engaged in or authorized to conduct any business similar to any business authorized to be conducted by this corporation, or owning property necessary or suitable for its purposes, and to pay for the same in cash, in stock of this corporation, or otherwise; to hold or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the business or property so acquired; and to exercise all the powers necessary or incidental to the conduct of such business.

(h) To borrow money, to issue bonds, debentures, notes and other obligations of their corporation from time to time, for any of the objects or purposes of this corporation, and to mortgage, pledge, hypothecate or convey in trust any or all of the property of the corporation to secure the payment thereof.

(i) To acquire and pay for in cash, shares of stock or notes of this corporation or otherwise, the assets, including the good will, of any person, firm, partnership association or corporation, and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the obligations or liabilities thereof.

(j) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, state, municipality, government or any subdivision, district, department, agency or instrumentality thereof.

(k) To do any and all such other acts, things, business or businesses in any manner connected with or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary to any of the objects hereinbefore enumerated or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation; and in carrying on its purposes or for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its business, to do any and all acts and things, and to exercise any and all other powers which a natural person could do or exercise and which now or hereafter may be authorized by law, and in any geographical location.

(l) The several clauses contained in this statement of purposes shall be construed as both purposes and powers, and the statements contained in each clause shall be in no wise limited or restricted

by reference to, or inference from, the terms of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers; and no recitation, expression or declaration of specific or special powers or purposes herein enumerated shall be deemed to be exclusive; but it is hereby declared that all other lawful powers not inconsistent herewith are hereby included.

ARTICLE III

That the location and post office address of the registered office and principal place of business of this corporation shall be: 1007 Jefferson Street, Boise, Ada County, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

That the period of existence and duration of life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

The number of shares of stock which may be issued by the corporation is One Hundred (100) shares, all of which shall be common stock with equal rights and participation, and without a nominal or par value. The capital stock of this corporation shall not be subject to assessment.

ARTICLE VI

The number of directors of this corporation shall be not less than three (3), nor more than seven (7) to be determined as provided in the By-Laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE VII

The names and post office address of each of the incorporators of this corporation, and the number of shares of stock of the corporation subscribed by each, is as follows:

ARTICLE VIII

No stockholder shall be liable for the debts of the corporation for any amount greater than his unpaid subscription to the capital stock as reflected upon the records of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX

No contract or other transaction between the corporation and any other corporation shall be affected or invalidated by the fact that any one or more of the directors of this corporation is or are interested in, or is a director or officer, or are directors or officers of such other corporation, and any director or directors, individually or jointly, may be a party or parties to or may be interested in any contract or transaction of this corporation or in which this corporation is interested; and no contract, act or transaction of this corporation with any person or persons, firm or association, shall be affected or invalidated by the fact that any director or directors of this corporation is a party,

or are parties, to or interested in such contract, act or transaction, or in any way connected with such person or persons, firm or association, and each and every person who may become a director of this corporation is hereby relieved from any liability that might otherwise exist from contracting with the corporation for the benefit of himself or any firm or corporation in which he may be in any wise interested.

ARTICLE X

The Board of Directors of the corporation shall have the power to adopt, amend and repeal the By-Laws of the corporation and the stockholders at annual or a special meeting called therefor, shall have power to adopt, amend and repeal such By-Laws.

ARTICLE XI

This corporation reserves the right to at any time amend, alter, change or repeal any provisions contained in this certificate in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by the statutes of the State of Idaho, and all rights conferred upon stockholders herein are granted subject to this reservation.
