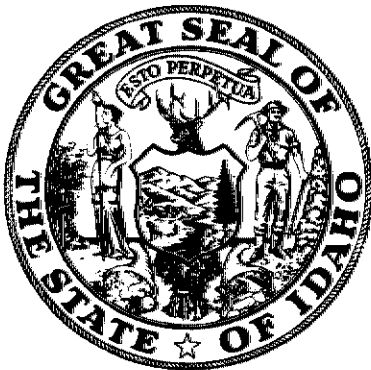

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

The Northwest Coalition Against Malicious Harassment Inc. hereby submits the following amendments to Articles Three, Four and Nine of its Articles of Incorporation, filed on April 30, 1987. These Articles, as amended by majority vote of members present at a special meeting of the membership held on December 4, 1987, read as follows:

ARTICLE THREE

PURPOSES

The corporation is organized exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Northwest Coalition Against Malicious Harassment will address the problem and threat of religious and racial harassment and violence through the following educational activities:

- a. determining the dimensions of the problems and monitoring the activities of racial and religious hate groups,
- b. assisting local communities to develop strategies,
- c. providing education to members and to others,
- d. encourage uniform crime reporting, and
- e. facilitating response of law enforcement agencies to incidents of harassment or violence.

ARTICLE FOUR

NON-PROFIT STATUS

The corporation is not organized for a pecuniary profit. The corporation shall be non-stock, and no dividends

on pecuniary profits shall be declared or paid to the members thereof, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to or for the corporation in carrying out one or more of its purposes.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

#### ARTICLE NINE

#### DISSOLUTION

Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious and/or scientific purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
