



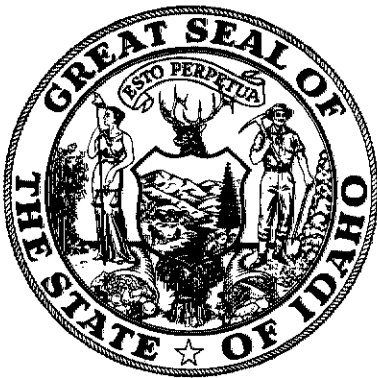
CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporators, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the Idaho Business Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Nanotek, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

A. To manufacture, develop, research and market computer components and other electronic equipment.

B. The transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation is to have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV

The address of the Corporation's initial registered office shall be 3430 Maiben Avenue, Ammon, County of Bonneville, State of Idaho and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Joseph D. George.

ARTICLE V

The capital stock of the Corporation shall be five thousand (5,000) shares of common stock, without par value. The capital stock of the Corporation shall not be assessable.
