was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twentieth** day of **December**, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-three** and is duly recorded on Film No. **126** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise** in the County of **Ada** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

of the

BOISE DUPLICATE BRIDGE ASSOCIATION, INC.

a non-profit association.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age, citizens of the United States of America, and residents of the State of Idaho, this day have voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a non-profit association under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify as follows:

I.

NAME

The name of this association shall be BOISE DUPLICATE BRIDGE ASSOCIATION, INC.

II.

PURPOSE

The purposes for which this association is formed are:

a) to sponsor and conduct duplicate bridge games under the rules and regulations as set out by the American Contract Bridge League.

b) to purchase or otherwise acquire the necessary material for conducting duplicate bridge games, including, but not limited to, playing cards, duplicate boards, tournament place cards, score sheets, writing implements, rule books, writing implements, directors' aides, and trophies.

c) to enter into rental agreements for the purpose of securing quarters and other needed facilities to conduct duplicate bridge games.

d) to collect playing fees and to donate excess funds accumulated from said playing fees to various charities as designated from time to time by the association's board of directors

e)to cooperate with the Boise Unit of the American Contract Bridge League in sponsoring sectional and regional duplicate bridge tournaments.

III.

DURATION

The existence of this association shall be perpetual.

IV.

LOCATION

The principle place of business and office of this association shall be Boise, Idaho.

V.

MEMBERSHIP

All members of the Boise Unit of the American Contract Bridge League who have paid their dues to the Boise Unit shall be members in good standing of this association. Members shall have one equal vote in the election of officers and in such matters as are left to the decision of the membership according to the association's bylaws.

VI.

DIRECTORS

The number of directors of the Boise Duplicate Bridge Association shall be not less than three nor more than thirteen. They shall be elected annually at the association's annual meeting and shall take office the next following January 1. Directors of the Boise Duplicate Bridge Association shall be the same as those elected by the Boise Unit of the American Contract Bridge League. Six directors will be elected annually for two year terms and the directors shall elect officers. The thirteenth director shall be the retiring president.
