ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

GENERAL FEED and GRAIN, INC.

an

Idaho Corporation

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, all full age citizens of the United States, this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be GENERAL FEED $^{a}n_{d}$ GRAIN, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- A. To conduct and carry on the business of buying, selling and dealing in all kinds of grain, seeds, hay, or other farm produce, and farm products, livestock, garden supplies, fertilizers, agricultural chemical products, provisions, and any kind of agricultural product or products relating to agriculture, and all other kinds of goods, wares and merchandise relative to any agricultural products, and to do a general commission and brokerage business in any or all of the foregoing kinds or property.
- B. To construct, acquire, operate, hire, lease, mortgage, sell, or otherwise dispose of elevators for elevating wheat, grain, all types of seed, or other produce, with the requisite docks, wharves, engines, plant, machinery, and appliances therefor, and also sheds,

stores, and warehouses for the reception and storage of wheat, grain, all types of seed, and other produce, and any other goods, wares, merchandise, and effects, and generally to carry on an elevator, seed milling and storage business.

- C. To generally engage in, do, and perform any enterprise, act, or vocation that a natural person might or could do.
- D. To purchase, or acquire through the issuance of its capital stock, or otherwise, own, hold, lease, either as lessor or lessee, sell, exchange, sub-divide, mortgage, deed in trust, plant, improve, farm, cultivate, develop, construct, maintain, equip, operate, and generally deal in any and all lands, improved and unimproved, seed mills, grain elevators, storage warehouses, dwelling houses, apartment houses, motels, boarding houses, business blocks, office buildings, trade centers, manufacturing works and plants, and other buildings of any kind and the products and avails thereof, and any and all other property of any and every kind or description, real, personal and mixed, wherever situated.
- E. To do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms, or individuals, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things, incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid objects or purposes, or any part or parts thereof, provided the same not be inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

ARTICLE III.

This corporation shall have perpetual existance.

ARTICLE IV.

The location and post office address of the registered office in this state and principle place of business shall be P. O. Box 748, --Bonners Ferry, County of Boundary, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

The amount of capital stock of said corporation shall be One Hundred Thousand and no/100 (\$100,000.00) Dollars, divided into one hundred thousand (100,000) shares, each of the value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share. All of said stock shall be common stock and non-assessable, having equal voting rights, powers, preferences and restrictions.

ARTICLE VI.

The name and post office address of each of the incorporators, and the number of shares of common stock described in Article V., subscribed by each, are as follows:

ARTICLE VII.

The number of directors of this corporation shall not be less than three nor more than seven. The number of directors, qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, and the powers and duties of the directors shall be further officered by a President, Vice-President and Secretary-Treasurer, all of whom shall be elected by the Board of Directors and shall hold office and have the powers to be specified in the By-Laws of this corporation.

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ARTICLE VIII.

The names, addresses and terms of office of the first directors are as follows:

ARTICLE IX.

Subject to the power of the shareholders to amend, alter or repeal, the Board of Directors of this corporation shall have the power to amend such By-Laws defining the powers and duties of the officers in the corporation, and providing for such other matters adjacent to its affairs that they may deem necessary and convenient, providing the same are not out of harmony with the laws of the State of Idaho, or these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE X.

An amendment altering the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation, in any respect, may be adopted by vote of the holders of the majority of the outstanding shares unless specifically prohibited by law, then by such vote as the law requires.
