## **Articles of Incorporation Attachment**

The Soup Kitchen

Article 2: The Soup Kitchen has been organized to provide meals to those in need in the community of Idaho Falls. Further, this organization is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of section 501 c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax as an organization described in section 501 c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future federal tax code). Upon the dissolution and winding up of this organization, after paying or adequately providing for debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation organized and operated exclusively for the purposes specified in section 501 c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and which has established its tax-exempt status under that section.
