### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

**THE CHURCH OF THE UNITED BROTHERS IN CHRIST, GILDERAS, IDAHO, INC.**

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twenty-sixth** day of **February**, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-four** and is duly recorded on Film No. **127** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Gilderas** in the County of **Max Perce** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF

THE CHURCH OF THE UNITED BRETHREN IN CHRIST, CULDESAC, IDAHO, INC.  
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating, under the laws of the State of Idaho, a religious corporation to be known as "The Church of the United Brethren in Christ, Culdesac, Idaho, Inc."

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be "THE CHURCH OF THE UNITED BRETHREN IN CHRIST, CULDESAC, IDAHO, INC."

ARTICLE II

The purpose and object for which this corporation is formed is as follows:

To establish and maintain a church in Culdesac, Idaho, and in connection therewith, a suitable and customary organization for the purpose of public worship and religious training according to the rules and discipline of the Church of the United Brethren in Christ as adopted, edited and published by authority of the General Conference of the Church of the United Brethren in Christ, in 1961, and which said church shall be subject to the government of the General Council of the Church of the United Brethren in Christ as from time to time authorized and declared by authority of the General Conference.

To purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, manage, sell, mortgage or otherwise encumber or dispose of real or personal property of any kind whatsoever; to receive, hold and issue bonds evidencing its indebtedness and to secure indebtedness by pledge, mortgage or other encumbrance of its property to rent and lease real property and to exercise all powers conferred upon it by law and all powers

necessary or incidental to the powers expressly enumerated.

#### ARTICLE III

The principal office of this corporation and the place where its principal business will be transacted will be at Culdesac, Idaho.

#### ARTICLE IV

That the corporation shall have perpetual existence.

#### ARTICLE V

That the number of trustees that shall have the management of its affairs as aforesaid, shall be three (3), and the names of the trustees elected for the first year are:

John M. Blewett	Culdesac, Idaho
Phyllis Blewett	Culdesac, Idaho
Hazel E. Presnall	Culdesac, Idaho

That all of the aforesaid trustees are over the age of 21 and citizens of the State of Idaho and of the United States of America.

That the said trustees were duly elected at a meeting of the members of the said church, duly convened and held at the home of John M. Blewett in Culdesac, Idaho, on the 24th day of February, 1964, at the hour of 7:30 p.m. of said day. Said meeting having been convened upon notice by publication as provided by the Idaho Code, and having convened for the purpose, among other things, of incorporating and electing trustees to take charge and management of its properties, temporalities, affairs and to form this corporation. That a majority of said members were there and then present and voted in such election for the above named trustees as is more particularly set forth in the certificate and verification by the officers who conducted the election hereto annexed and made a part of these Articles.

ARTICLE VI

The corporation shall have the power to make By-Laws for the guidance and control of the trustees and other officers and agents of this corporation in managing its affairs, and thereafter the trustees in power shall, at any time, have power to make such additional prudential by-laws or amendments of any by-laws for the guidance and direction of the trustees and other officers and agents of this corporation in the transaction of its business affairs as may become necessary, convenient or advantageous from time to time for carrying out the objects and purposes of the corporation in an orderly and businesslike way, and such additions or amendments to the by-laws shall be made as provided in the by-laws to be done, provided, however, that the said by-laws, made as aforesaid, shall not be repugnant to the laws of the State and shall be consonant with the objects of the corporation, and the origin, doctrine, constitution and discipline of the Church of the United Brethren in Christ as published by authority of the General Conference of 1961.

ARTICLE VII

That the members of this corporation shall be all persons who now are or hereafter become members of the Church of the United Brethren in Christ, Culdesac, Idaho, under the rules and discipline of the said church as embodied and set forth in the manual of the said church published by authority of the General Assembly in the year 1961.



This is to certify that at a meeting of the members of the CHURCH OF THE UNITED BRETHREN IN CHRIST, CULDESAC, IDAHO, duly convened for the purpose of incorporating the said church and electing trustees to take charge of its properties and affairs and to form the corporation and the said meeting having been held in Culdesac, Idaho, on the 24th day of February, 1964, at the hour of 7:30 p.m. on said day as provided for in the Notice of Publication, the same having been published three (3) times in the LEWISTON MORNING TRIBUNE, Lewiston, Idaho, in the manner required by law, and a majority of the members being then and there present, the following proceedings were had.

B.W. Presnell was requested to preside and Mrs. Billie Hammond to act as secretary, with which requests they respectively complied.

The meeting then proceeded with the election of three (3) trustees to take charge of the property, temporalities and affairs of the Church of the United Brethren in Christ, Culdesac, Idaho, and to form an incorporation under the laws of the State of Idaho in furtherance of the object for which the church is founded. Proposed Articles of Incorporation were then read and approved.

The following trustees were then duly elected, to-wit:

The trustees were then authorized and instructed to proceed with the incorporation.
