

## **ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**



To the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho

The undersigned, in order to form a Corporation under the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 1, Idaho Code, submits the following articles of incorporation:

Article 1: The name of the corporation shall be: Conquest Insurance Services, Inc.

Article 2: The number of shares the corporation is authorized to issue is: 10,000

Article 5: The mailing address of the corporation shall be: P.O. Box 69, Blackfoot, ID 83221

### Optional articles:

**Article 6: The Corporation shall indemnify any person who incurs expenses or liabilities by reason of the fact he or she is or was an officer or director of the Corporation, or is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as a director or officer of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, or other enterprise. This indemnification shall be mandatory in all circumstances in which indemnification is permitted by law.**

Article 7: To the fullest extent permitted by Idaho Statutes as the same exists or may hereafter be amended, no director shall be liable to the Corporation or its stockholders for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director.

No repeal of modification of the foregoing paragraph by the stockholders of the Corporation shall adversely affect any right or protection of a director existing at the time of such repeal or modification.
