The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Idaho Business Incorporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is AAA TRANSPORT,

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- A. To carry on any and all kinds of business or business activities that the Board of Directors may from time to time deem to be advisable or proper in connection with the home construction or renovation business.
- B. To purchase, lease, own, sell, mortgage, sublease, and otherwise acquire lands, buildings, easements or property, real and personal, which may be requisite, and have the attributes necessary for the purposes of the objectives of this corporation, and to enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind with any person, and to acquire and take over the good will, property, rights, franchises and assets of every kind and the liabilities of any person, firm, association, or corporation, either wholly or in part, and to pay for the same in cash, stocks or bonds of the corporation, or otherwise.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue in ONE HUNDRED (100), with no par value, with a total capital stock on ONE HUNDRED (100) shares, and shall be nonassessable when paid in full.

FIFTH: Provisions denying preemptive rights are: None.

SIXTH: Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are: None.

SEVENTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 152 Heyburn West, Twin Falls, Idaho 83301, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is HOWARD D. SMITH.

EIGHTH: The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is two (2). The number may be changed by the Bylaws of the corporation, and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of the shareholders or until a successor or successors are elected and shall qualify are:
