cessors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for

and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit coopera-
tive Associations, as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

TWIN LAKES IMPROVEMENT ASSN., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit cooperative association under the provisions of Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify that:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be TWIN LAKES IMPROVEMENT ASSN., INC.

ARTICLE II.

The period of time for which this corporation shall exist shall be fifty (50) years from and after its incorporation.

ARTICLE III.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

(1). To improve and promote the development of the lakes in Kootenai County, Idaho, known as Twin Lakes, particularly with reference to their mean, high and low water elevation, and to stabilize the water level.

(2). To recommend to constituted lawful authorities the opinion of the majority of its members for the best interests of the residents in the area served by the waters of said lakes.

(3). To seek and preserve sanitary conditions and regulations in the interests of public health in the waters and upon the immediate surrounding lakeshore of that lake.

(4). To protect, propagate and increase fish and natural foods therefor in said lakes and to procure the enactment of laws for the protection and restoration of fish and natural foods of

said lake and to promote the observance and enforcement of such laws.

(5). To promote the protection of Twin Lakes and the general welfare of the areas affected by, or dependent on, its waters as against all injurious or detrimental uses.

(6). To promote the protection of the inhabitants of the Twin Lakes area and their use of said lakes for business and recreational purposes, including, specifically, the control of water craft and fire protection of the improvements in and about said lakes.

(7). To affiliate or associate itself with similar organizations.

(8). To by any lawful means purchase, hold, have and use such real and personal properties as are necessary and expedient to accomplish the above stated purposes.

ARTICLE IV.

This corporation is one which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit by or for the members thereof.

ARTICLE V.

The place where the principal business is to be transacted is Rathdrum, Idaho.

ARTICLE VI.

The general management of the policy, affairs, funds and property of this association shall be vested in a Board of Directors of not more than fifteen (15) nor less than nine (9), a majority of whom shall constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE VII.

All persons, copartnerships, associations or corporations

owning, or being the contract purchaser of, real property within an one-half mile radius of the shore line of Upper Twin or Lower Twin Lakes, in Kootenai County, Idaho, shall be eligible for membership in this association.

ARTICLE VIII.

That this corporation shall not issue any capital stock, but shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof in such form as may be adopted and approved by the Board of Directors, which certificates shall be evidence of membership herein. Said certificates shall not be assignable or transferable except by the approval of the Board of Directors, and under such other regulations as may be prescribed by the By-Laws to be adopted.

ARTICLE IX.

That the following are names and places of residence of the directors first elected of this corporation who shall hold office until the next regular annual meeting as provided for in the By-Laws of this corporation, or until their successors have been elected and qualified:

ARTICLE X.

That the election of the above named directors was held at Twin Lakes, Kootenai County, Idaho, in the Community Hall, on the 30th day of September, 1956, and that a majority of the members of said Association were present and voted at said meeting and the result thereof was the election of the directors above named.

ARTICLE XI.

That the By-Laws of said Association may, in addition to

other provisions, provide for the number and qualification of members, and the terms and conditions of admission; the time and mode, conditions and effect of expulsion or withdrawal from, and restoration to membership; fees for admission, assessments or dues to carry on the business of the corporation and reimburse for services rendered and expenses incurred by the Association for its members; time of payment and the matter of collecting amounts due and for forfeiture of the interest of the members in the corporation for non-payment thereof, and such other regulations and rules as are not repugnant to the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE XII.

That the By-Laws of the corporation shall be adopted by the directors named in these Articles of Incorporation and may thereafter be amended or repealed by any means provided by the By-Laws.


