Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, liquidate all of the assets of the corporation into cash, and be donated to various local charties, or to such other organization or organizations as shall at the time qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, in such manner as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so distributed shall be distributed by the District Court of the country in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as such court shall determine to be consistent with the purposes of the corporation.
