

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
H & H INVESTORS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, citizens of the United States of America, of full legal age, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and to that end we hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is, and shall be, "H & H INVESTORS, INC."

ARTICLE II

The corporation existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

That the purposes for which it is formed are as follows:

- 1) To engage in the business of purchasing, acquiring, owning, leasing, selling, financing the sale by installment contract or otherwise, encumbering, generally dealing in repairing, renovating and servicing all types of new and used automobiles, trucks, and other motor vehicles, boats, motors, and boat trailers, and any parts or accessories used in connection therewith; and the purchasing, acquiring, owning, selling, and generally dealing in all types of supplies used by all types of motor vehicles and boats, motors and trailers.
- 2) To sell and assign executed installment sales contracts.
- 3) To purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, lease, sell, exchange, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of, to guarantee, and to invest, trade and deal in and with personal property of every class and description.
- 4) To purchase or otherwise acquire, own, hold, lease sell, exchange,

assign, transfer, mortgage or otherwise dispose of, and to invest, trade and deal in and with real property, and any and all interests therein.

5) To enter into any kind of contract or agreement, co-operative or profit-sharing plan with its officers or employees that the corporation may deem advantageous or expedient or otherwise to reward or pay such persons for their services as the directors may deem fit.

6) To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, in whole or in part, the business, goodwill, rights, franchises and property of every kind, and to undertake the whole or any part of the assets or liabilities, of any person, firm, association or corporation engaged in or authorized to conduct any business similar to any business authorized to be conducted by this corporation, or owning property necessary or suitable for its purposes, and to pay for the same in cash, in the stock or bonds of this company, or otherwise; to hold or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the business or property to be acquired, and to exercise all the powers necessary or incidental to the conduct of such business.

7) To lend money and to negotiate and make loans, either on its own account or as agent or broker for others.

8) To borrow money, to issue bonds, debentures, notes and other obligations of this corporation, from time to time, for any of the objects or purposes of this corporation, and to mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, and/or convey in trust, any or all of its property to secure the payment thereof.

9) To discount and negotiate promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, and other evidence of debt, and to collect for others money due them on notes, checks, drafts, bills of exchange, commercial paper and other evidences of indebtedness.

10) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, state, or government, or any subdivision,

district, or department thereof.

11) To acquire, and pay for in cash, shares of stock, bonds or notes of this corporation, or otherwise, the assets including the goodwill of any person, firm, association or corporation, and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the obligations or liabilities thereof.

12) To engage in and conduct any and all kinds of manufacturing businesses.

13) To do any and all such other acts, things, business or businesses in any manner connected with or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary to any of the objects hereinbefore enumerated, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation; and in carrying on its purposes, or for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its business, to do any and all acts and things, and to exercise any and all other powers, which a copartner or natural person could do or exercise, and which now or hereafter may be authorized by law, and in this part of the world.

14) To have offices, conduct its business, and promote its objects within and without the State of Idaho, in other states, the District of Columbia, the territories and colonies of the United States, and in foreign countries, without restriction as to place or amount.

15) The several clauses contained in this statement of purposes shall be construed as both purposes and powers, and the statements contained in each clause shall be in nowise limited or restricted, by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers; and no recitation, expression or declaration of specific or special powers or purposes herein enumerated shall be deemed to be exclusive; but it is hereby expressly declared that all other lawful powers not inconsistent herewith are hereby included.

ARTICLE IV

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be the City of Sandpoint, Bonner County, Idaho.

ARTICLE V

That the amount of the capital stock in this corporation shall be Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars divided into one hundred (100) shares of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars each.

ARTICLE VI

That the amount of capital stock which has actually been subscribed is Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars; and the following are the names of the persons and the post office address of each of the incorporators and a statement of the number of shares subscribed by each.
