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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, the undersigned, being a natural person and of full age and citizen of the United States, by these presents for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to the corporation laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

I

That the name of the corporation is IT'S LEGAL, INC.

II

That the purpose for which said corporation is formed is:

To engage in the performance of legal assistant and legal secretarial duties, including, but not limited to preparation of legal documents and transcription; to conduct the aforesaid business and all of its branches; and to do such other things as are incidental, proper, or necessary in the operation of the business and in the carrying out of any or all of its purposes.

To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of, convey, mortgage and/or lease real and personal property, to dispose of, sell, lease, assign, transfer, mortgage and/or convey any rights, privileges, franchises, real or personal property of the corporation, other than its franchise of being a corporation, and to acquire, purchase, guarantee, hold, mortgage or vote, sell, pledge or otherwise dispose of and deal in buying bonds and securities and debentures and other evidence of indebtedness of other corporations, foreign or domestic.

To carry on any other business, whether sales, leasing or otherwise, which may, in the discretion of the Directors, seem capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with the above, or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of the company's property or rights, and to do any and all of the above things, or any part thereof as principals, agents, contractors, or otherwise, and by or through agents or otherwise, and either alone or in conjunction with the others, and generally to attain and further any of the purposes herein set forth or incidental to the business of the company, or to any of the powers herein specified; to make, guarantee and perform any contracts of

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any kind and description, and to do any and all other acts and things and exercise any and all other powers which a co-partnership or natural persons could do, and exercise, and which now or hereafter may be authorized by law.

To exercise all authority conferred upon corporations by Section 30-1-4 of the Idaho Code, and, in addition thereto, to purchase its own stock and to enter it upon its books as treasury stock or to cancel it or re-issue it, and in general to deal and trade in its own stock.

III

The corporation is to have perpetual existence, subject only to dissolution in the manner provided by law.

IV

The location of the registered office of the corporation is 605 Mountain View Drive, Twin Falls, Idaho 83301; the name of the registered agent at that address is Marie Fletcher.

V

The total number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 100 shares, each having no par value.

VI

The name and post office address of each of the incorporators thereto and a statement of the number of shares subscribed by each is as follows:

The private property of the stockholders of the corporation shall not be subject to the payment of the corporation debts to any extent whatever, and the shares of the corporation shall not be subject to assessment for the purpose of paying expenses, conducting business or paying debts of the corporation or for any

other reason.

IX

The number of directors of the corporation shall be as specified in the By-Laws, and each number may from time to time be increased or decreased in such manner as may be prescribed in the By-Laws, providing the number of directors shall not be less than one.

X

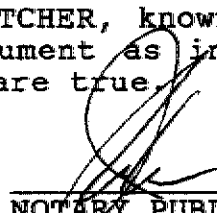
