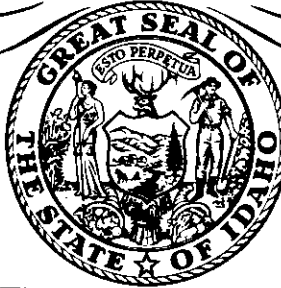

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

IDAHO REFRIGERATION CORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being natural persons over the age of twenty-one years, and citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho.

And we hereby certify in writing:

I.

That the name of this corporation shall be "IDAHO REFRIGERATION CORPORATION".

II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

(1) To own, maintain and operate all or any of the businesses of ice makers, ice manufacturers, ice dealers, refrigerating storekeepers and to operate a general ice and cold storage business.

(2) Directly, or through ownership of stock in any corporation, to purchase, lease, exchange, or otherwise acquire real estate and property, either improved or unimproved, and any interest therein; to own, hold, control, maintain, manage and develop the same; to erect, construct, maintain, improve, rebuild, enlarge, alter, manage, operate, and control all kinds of buildings, and all structures and erections of any description on any lands owned, held, or leased by the corporation, or upon any other lands; to lease or sublet space in such building or buildings, and to sell, lease, sublet, mortgage, exchange, assign, transfer, convey, pledge, or otherwise alienate or dispose of any of such real estate and property, and any interest therein.

(3) Directly, or through ownership of stock in any corporation, to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, sell, exchange, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, deal in, personal property of every kind, and any interest therein and to manufacture goods and commodities from raw materials consisting in whole or in part of agricultural products or processed agricultural products;

1 (4) To buy, sell, transport and otherwise acquire and dispose of
2 processed agricultural products and manufactured goods made in whole or in
3 part of agricultural products or processed agricultural products;

4 (5) To engage in scientific and technical research and experiment
5 for the purpose of discovering and developing new commodities to be made
6 from agricultural products or processed agricultural products and for the
7 purpose of developing new processes, techniques, and methods and improving
8 known processes, techniques and methods in the processing of agricultural
9 commodities and manufacture of goods from raw materials which consist in
10 whole or in part of agricultural products or processed agricultural products.

11 (6) To engage in the general warehousing business, both as private
12 and public warehouse of agricultural and other commodities, and to give bond
13 and otherwise qualify and be licensed under applicable laws, both State and
14 Federal, applying to warehousemen both public and private; to qualify when
15 necessary or desirable for a license as weigher, grader, or inspector of
16 agricultural and allied commodities; to guarantee or furnish bond for individuals
17 to be licensed and act as weighers, graders or inspectors of agricultural
18 commodities under applicable laws.

19 (7) To carry on any other kind of business or business activities
20 convenient or necessary in connection with any of the business activities
21 specifically set forth above.

22 (8) To purchase, lease, own, sell, mortgage, sub-lease, and other-
23 wise acquire and dispose of lands, buildings, easements and all rights in
24 real property as well as personal property which may be requisite for the
25 purposes or are capable of being conveniently used in connection with any of
26 the objects of this corporation, and to enter into, make, perform and carry out
27 contracts of every sort and kind with any person and to acquire and take over
28 the good will, property, rights, franchises and assets of every kind and the
29 liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation either in whole or
30 in part and to pay for the same in cash, stock or bonds of the corporation or
31 otherwise.

1 (9) To borrow money and otherwise obtain credit for the account
2 of said corporation, and to issue debentures or other evidences of indebtedness
3 therefor and to obligate the assets of the corporation as security for such
4 indebtedness; to act as surety and guarantor in any and all types of engage-
5 ments including the power to execute, endorse and deliver contracts, and to
6 guarantee the prompt and faithful performance and payment of debts, notes,
7 agreements, contracts and undertakings of any other person, firm, partnership
8 or corporation; and including also the power to act as an accommodation,
9 co-maker or guarantor of obligations either as primary or secondary obligor.

10 (10) In the purchase of or acquisition of property, business rights
11 or franchises or for any other object in and about its business or affairs,
12 to incur debt and to borrow and secure the payment of money in any lawful
13 manner including the issue and sale or other disposition of bonds, debentures,
14 notes and other evidences of indebtedness.

15 (11) To exercise all or any of the corporate powers and to carry
16 out all or any of the purposes, enumerated herein or otherwise granted or
17 permitted by law, while acting as agent, nominee, or attorney in fact for any
18 persons or corporations, and to perform any service under contract or other-
19 wise for any corporation, joint stock company, association, partnership, firm,
20 syndicate, individual, or other entity, and in such capacity or under such
21 arrangement, to develop, improve, stabilize, strengthen, or extend the property
22 and commercial interests thereof, and to aid, assist, or participate in any
23 lawful enterprises in connection therewith or incidental to such agency,
24 representation, or service, and to render any other service or assistance in
25 so far as it lawfully may under the General Business Corporation Law of Idaho.

26 (12) To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient
27 for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the
28 objects, or the futherance of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone
29 or associated with others, and incidental or pertaining to, or growing out of, or
30 connected with, its business or powers, provided the same be not inconsistent
31 with the laws of the State of Idaho.
