tive Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION OF
INTERMOUNTAIN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, each being a natural person of full age and a citizen of the United States, have this day and do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit cooperative association under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 10 of Title 30 of the Idaho Code, and all acts amendatory thereof, and to that end we do hereby sign, acknowledge and adopt in triplicate, the following Articles of Incorporation, namely:

Article I

The name of this Association is: Intermountain Arabian Horse Association, Inc.

Article II

The purposes and objects for which this association is formed are:

Section 1. To improve the Arabian horse. To disseminate knowledge and information concerning the Arabian horse. To employ lecturers or teachers to put on demonstrations to effect the purpose of this organization. To promote good horsemanship and good fellowship among the members of the organization.

Section 2. To have, exercise and enjoy all the powers and privileges now or hereafter granted to non-profit cooperative associations under the laws of the State of Idaho and particularly by Chapter 10 of Title 30, Idaho Code, and any amendments thereto, and to do any act or thing necessary or convenient for the carrying out of the objects and purposes of a non-profit cooperative Association, and carrying into effect any and all of the aforesaid objects and purposes, and any and all acts incidental thereto.

Article III

This Association shall exist for a period of twenty (20) years.

Article IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of this Association in the State of Idaho is 1112 Idaho Street, Boise, Ada County, Idaho, where its principal business is to be transacted.

Article V

This Association shall have no capital stock and any natural person, and any corporation, association or co-partnership enumerated in Section 30-1003, Idaho Code, may become a member of this Association,

subject to and under such rules and regulations as the board of directors and the by-laws of this Association may from time to time establish. Certificates of membership shall be issued to each member of the Association, which certificate cannot be assigned so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of the Association, except by resolution of the board of directors and under such regulations as the by-laws may prescribe. The rights and interests of all members shall be equal.

Article VI

The business of this Association shall be managed and conducted by a board of directors (or trustees) consisting of persons, who shall be elected annually as and when provided for by the by-laws, and by such executive officers as may be appointed by said board of directors or elected by the membership to carry on said business under and by virtue of any by-laws which may from time to time be adopted by this Association.

Article VII

The by-laws of this Association may be amended or repealed and new by-laws adopted at any time by a two-thirds affirmative vote of the board of directors or by the members.


