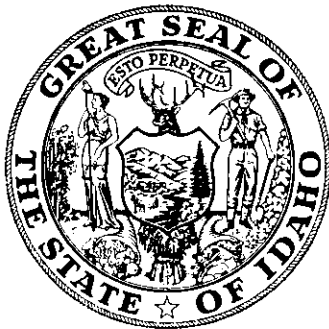

On August 28, 1996, at the hour of 2:00 p.m., a Corporation Shareholders Meeting, which was properly noticed to Shareholders: Ruth Rodeen, Ray Rodeen, and John Schnuerle, was held at the law office of Jeanette I. Thiel, 504 Main Street #475, Lewiston, Idaho. A quorum was present.

All debts of the corporation have been paid in full except the personal loan from Ruth Rodeen which debt was partially discharged to Ruth Rodeen in exchange for the remaining assets of the corporation pursuant to a unanimous vote at the August 28, 1996, Shareholders Meeting, and payment of \$34.74 per share from Shareholders by contribution.

The dissolution received a unanimous vote pursuant to a resolution to dissolve as required by I.C. 30-1-84, on August 28, 1996.

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




