# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

# THE CRANKERS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being all natural persons and citizens of the United States of America, of legal age, do on this 20 day of May, 1960, hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation of social and fraternal character under the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 11 of the Idaho Code, and we do hereby adopt and certify the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

# ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be "THE CRANKERS, INC."

ARTICLE II.

That location of the principal office and the place where the principal business of said corporation is to be transacted is in the City of Lewiston, County of Nez Perce, State of Idaho.

#### ARTICLE III.

That this corporation is formed for the purposes and shall have power:

- (1) To promote mutual, educational and scientific interests and benefits to its members; to promote the interest of its members in the collection, restoration, operation, history and exhibition of various forms of conveyance, and particularly of antique automobiles, and in modes of travel and dress in theearly age of motor vehicle transportation.
- (2) To promote the study by members, and to encourage through study, lectures, books, literature, demonstrations and

and other means, greater interest and knowledge concerning the motoring historyof this and other countries, and the methods of repairing, restoring and operating vehicles and particularly antique automobiles.

- (3) To encourage formation of clubs, associations and corporations for the purposes herein mentioned; to affiliate with and secure the affiliation of clubs, associations and corporations with this corporation for mutual benefits.
- (4) To issue by publication or otherwise, itemsof interest, manuscripts, circulars and other writings, or otherwise, for the benefit of its members and affiliated organizations.
- (5) To own by purchase, lease, exchange or otherwise acquire and dispose of, personal and real property necessary, incidental, auxiliary or convenient to the business of this corporation and its purposes and objects.
- (6) To conduct tours, and exhibitions, and to hold meets, picnics and other activities for the educational and social benefit of its members, affiliated groups and friends.
- manner, all real and personal property whatsoever, as may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of carrying into effect any one or more of the objects herein mentioned, and to mortgage, hypothecate, pledge, sell and otherwise dispose of said property; to borrow money and to do all acts, and to make, execute and deliver all necessary instruments for the carrying on of the said purposes; to enter into contracts, to borrow money, lend money and to evidence the indebtedness of the corporation by notes, bonds or other instruments and to secure the same by pledge, mortgage, trust deed or other instruments as to the corporation may seem proper.

- (8) To conduct its affairs and activities either within or without the State of Idaho, to have such meetings, and meeting places either within or without the said State of Idaho, as shall be in the best interests of its members.
- (9) To do any and all things convenient and incidental to the purposes herein expressed, and generally to have and to exercise all such powers as are by law conferred on corporations of like character through this corporation or by and through, principals, agents, attorneys, trustees, contractors, factors, lessors, lessees or otherwise, either alone on in connection with others.

#### ARTICLE IV.

That the duration of this corporation shall be unlimited and perpetual.

#### ARTICLE V.

That this corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit, and shall not issue capital stock; the corporation shall issue a membership certificate to each of its members, and the interest of each member in the corporation shall be equal and identical to the interest of every other member therein; such membership certificate and membership in the corporation shall be non-assignable and non-transferable.

### ARTICLE VI.

That the number of directors of this corporation shall be not less than five (5) nor more than fifteen (15), as may be fixed by the by-laws; they shall have the management of the real estate and property of this corporation and their qualification and terms of office, manner of election (except the first board of directors who were elected for a term as set forth herein), time, place and manner of calling meetings, and powers and duties of the directors shall

be set forth and prescribed in the by-laws.

#### ARTICLE VII.

The officers of this corporation shall consist of a president, a vice-president, a treasurer and a secretary, PROVIDED, THAT, the office of treasurer and secretary may be combined in one person if so provided in the by-laws, and their qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, and other powers and duties shall be prescribed by the by-laws.

# ARTICLE VIII.

That a duly called meeting of the members of The Crankers Club, was held at the Gene LeWebre Home, 916 Bryden Avenue, Lewiston Orchards, Idaho, on the 20th day of May, 1960, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P. M. for the purpose of electing directors of this corporation; that Notice of the time and place of holding such meeting and election was given by publication thereof for theeweeks prior to the said meeting in the Lewiston Morning Tribune, a newspaper in general circulation published at Lewiston, Idaho, the first publication thereof being on the 27th day of April, 1960, and the last publication thereof being on the 11th day of May, 1960, and also by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place at the said Gene LeFebre Home for more than two weeks immediately preceding said election; that a majority of the members of The Crankers Club who were present at the said meeting voted at such election of directors.

That at said meeting the following persons were duly elected directors of this corporation, for the term below indicated, by majority vote by the members present at said meeting, as follows:
