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**FIRST AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF

This First Amendment to Articles of Incorporation (the "*First Amendment*") of LifeSketch Systems, Inc., an Idaho corporation (the "*Corporation*"), has been duly adopted by the directors and shareholders of the Corporation. The original Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation were filed in the office of the Idaho Secretary of State on March 25, 2008 (the "*Articles*"), and have not been amended since that date. This First Amendment is filed to reflect the approval of the directors and shareholders of the Corporation to: (i) change the name of the Corporation; and (ii) change the aggregate number of shares the Corporation is authorized to issue and to designate separate classes of voting and non-voting common stock.

Pursuant to Sections 30-1-1003 and 30-1-1006 of the Act, the undersigned president of the Corporation certifies:

1. Name. The name of the corporation is LifeSketch Systems, Inc.
2. Amendment. The Articles are hereby amended as follows:

The FIRST ARTICLE is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following text:

"The name of the corporation is Sianna Images, Inc."

The FOURTH ARTICLE is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following text:

"The aggregate number of shares the corporation is authorized to issue shall be a total of two million (2,000,000) shares (without par value), consisting of one million (1,000,000) shares of Class A voting common stock and one million (1,000,000) shares of Class B non-voting common stock. The rights of the holders of shares of Class A voting common stock and the rights of the holders of shares of Class B non-voting common stock shall be identical in all respects, except that only the holders of shares of Class A voting common stock shall have voting rights. The holders of shares of Class B non-voting common stock shall have no voting rights whatsoever with respect to the corporation, including without limitation no class voting rights and voting group rights under Idaho Code Sections 30-1-1004 and 30-1-1104.

Unless a resolution of the board of directors of the corporation provides that reacquired shares shall constitute authorized but unissued shares, any shares reacquired by the corporation shall be

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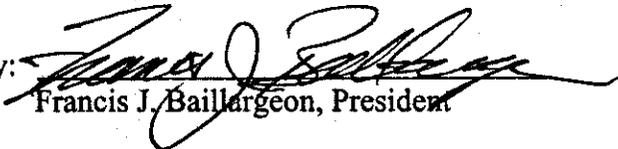
treasury shares; and the corporation may hold, use, resell or disposed of such reacquired shares free of any restrictions that would be imposed on the original issuance of shares of the corporation.”

3. Approval by Directors. This First Amendment was duly approved and recommended to the shareholders of the Corporation for their approval by the Unanimous Consent of the Directors of the Corporation, dated effective July 14, 2008, pursuant to Idaho Code Sections 30-1-821 and 30-1-1006.

4. Shareholder Approval. Shareholder approval of this First Amendment was required, and thus this First Amendment was duly approved by the Unanimous Consent of the Shareholders of the Corporation, dated effective July 14, 2008, pursuant to the Articles and Idaho Code Sections 30-1-704, 30-1-1003, and 30-1-1006.
