KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of organizing a private corporation, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby set forth and declare as follows:

1st. That the name of this corporation is and shall be, STONE AND RAMSDELL COMPANY, LIMITED.

2d. That the purposes for which this corporation is formed, are:

Carrying on and conducting a general wholesale and retail merchandising business; buying and selling goods, wares and merchandise; acquiring, purchasing, owning, leasing and holding such real property as may be necessary in conducting such mercantile business; selling, conveying, hypothecating and mortgaging such real and personal property or any part thereof; buying, selling and handling goods, wares and merchandise on commission; doing and performing such contracting in the erection of buildings and other structures as may aid in selling and disposing of the goods, wares and merchandise embraced in such mercantile business, and the doing and performing all such other acts and things as may be essential to the full and complete carrying into effect the purposes above set forth.

3d. That the place where the principal business of this corporation shall be transacted, is Boise in the County of Ada, State of Idaho.

4th. That the term for which this corporation shall exist is fifty years.

5th. That the number of directors of this corporation shall be five, and the names and residences of those who are appointed as directors for the first year of the life of this corporation are as follows:
