THE UNDERSIGNED, in order to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the provisions of Title 30, Chapters 21 and 30, Idaho Code, submits the following articles of incorporation to the Secretary of State.

Article 1: Name

The name of the corporation shall be Dry Creek Community Church, Inc.

Article 2: Purpose

The corporation is organized exclusively for the charitable, religious and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding provisions of any future Federal tax code.

Article 3: Registered Agent Name and Address

The registered agent for the corporation is Paul R. Powell, 13061 N. Andy's Gulch Rd., Boise, ID 83714.

Article 4: Board of Directors

The board of directors shall consist of no fewer than three (3) people. The names and addresses of the initial directors are:

Article 6: Mailing Address

The mailing address of the corporation shall be 13061 N. Andy's Gulch Rd., Boise, ID 83714.

Article 7: Voting Rights

The corporation does not have voting members.

Article 8: Non-Profit Corporation

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 2 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article 9: Amendments to Articles of Incorporation

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by statute or by the vote and subsequent approval of the Board of Directors.

Article 10: Term

The term of the corporation shall be perpetual or until dissolved according to law.

Article 11: Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to a state or local government for a public purpose as determined by the Board of Directors.
