ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

OMEGA CONSTRUCTION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the general corporation laws of the State of Idaho, and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereof, do hereby certify as follows:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is OMEGA CONSTRUCTION, INC.

The purposes and objects for which the SECOND: corporation is formed are: any and all lawful business, purposes or activity included but not limited to the carrying on of all or any of the construction of buildings, structures and improvements upon real property of every kind and nature.

THIRD: The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

FOURTH: The location and post office address of the registered agent is William C. Dodge, 7272 Colt Drive, Boise, Idaho 83705.

FIFTH: The amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be and is 25,000 shares of stock of the par value of \$1.00 each, making an aggregate stock of \$25,000 which stock shall not be issued until fully paid for and once so issued shall be non-assessable.

SIXTH: The name and post office address of the incorporators and first Board of Directors and number of shares of each are:

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SEVENTH: The private property of the stockholders of the corporation shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts to any extent whatever, and the shares of the corporation shall not be subject to assessment for the purpose of paying expenses, conducting business, or paying debts of the corporation.

EIGHTH: The number of Directors of the corporation shall be as specified in the By-Laws, and such number may from time to time be increased or decreased in such manner as may be prescribed in the By-Laws or in accordance with Section 30-1-36, Idaho Code. In case of any increase in the number of Directors, the additional Directors may be elected by the Directors then in office, and the Directors so elected shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the stockholders and until their successors are elected and qualified.

NINTH: Stockholders of the corporation shall have pre-emptive and preferential rights of subscription to any shares of stock of the corporation, whether now or hereafter authorized, or to any obligations convertible into stock of the corporation, or to obligations of the corporation convertible into stock. Any stock or obligations issued by the corporation shall first be offered to the stockholders of the corporation.

TENTH: A voluntary sale, lease or exchange of all of the property and assets of the corporation, including its good will and its corporate franchises, may be made by the Board of Directors upon such terms and conditions as it may deem expedient for the best interests of the corporation, but only when such act is authorized by the vote of holders of two-thirds of the voting ower of all shareholders.

ELEVENTH: No contract or other transaction between the corporation and no act of the corporation shall in any way be affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the directors of the corporation are pecuniarily or otherwise interested in, or are directors

or officers of, such other corporation, any director individually, or any firm of which any director may be a member, may be a party to, or may be pecuniarily or otherwise interested in, any contract or transaction of the corporation, provided that the fact that he or such firm is so interested shall be disclosed or shall have been known to the Board of Directors or a majority thereof, and any director of the corporation who is also a director or officer of such other corporation, or who is so interested, may be counted in determining the existence of a quorum at any meeting of the Board of Directors of the corporation which shall authorize any such contract or any such transaction with like force and effect as if he were not such director or officer of such other corporation or not so interested.

TWELFTH: The Board of Directors is expressly authorized to repeal and amend the By-Laws of the corporation and to adopt new By-Laws and the corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal, any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation, in the manner now, or hereafter, prescribed by law, by a majority vote of the stockholders, represented in person or by proxy, at any annual meeting of the stockholders or at any meeting duly called for that purpose, except where the laws of the said State of Idaho otherwise provide.
