

ARTICLE I. NAME.

The name of the corporation is Sojourners' Alliance, Inc.

ARTICLE V. PURPOSES.

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized and will be operated are as follows:

- A. To work toward a community vision of dignity and equality for all people. Our mission is to promote the personal growth, empowerment, and self-sufficiency of people in transition by providing basic services, education in life and interpersonal skills, counseling, and opportunities for integration into the community.
- B. To be charitable, educational, or scientific in nature within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under such Section 501 (c) (3).
- C. To exercise all powers granted by law necessary and proper to carry out the above stated purposes, including but not limited to the power to accept donations of money, property, whether real or personal, or any other thing of value. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorize or permit the Corporation to carry on any business for profit, to exercise any power, or to do any act that a corporation formed under the Act, or any amendment thereto or substitute therefor, may not at that time lawfully carry on or do.
