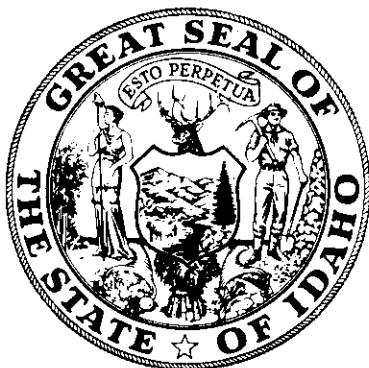

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

1. The name of this corporation shall be HEYWOOD HARVESTING COMPANY.

2. The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

3. The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Idaho as said laws may be amended from time to time.

4. The corporation initially intends to engage in the business of custom harvesting, however, this initial intent shall not limit the purpose or power of the corporation.

5. The corporation shall have authority to issue one million shares of common stock without par value.
