ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE CHAYOSE AIDS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, members of a non-profit organization, in accordance with the rules of said organization, do hereby associate ourselves together to form a non-profit corporation under Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code ~~annotated~~, and we do hereby certify as follows:

I.

That the name of this corporation is "THE CHAYOSE AIDS, INC."

II.

That the purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed are:

- A. To develop horsemanship and sportmanship among its members.
- B. To develop friendly relationships with other riding groups^{and horse organizations} throughout this state and elsewhere.
- C. To encourage friendly participation in all mounted activities, games and sports.
- D. To provide its members with the fullest possible instruction in correct horsemanship, proper care and management of mounts, and all phases of horse ownership.
- E. To carry on the business of furnishing entertainment, amusement and recreation to the public.
- F. To engage in such other business^{or} activities as, in the opinion of the Board of Directors, may further any of the foregoing purposes or powers and to do all things necessary and proper in carrying out the business of the association.

III.
