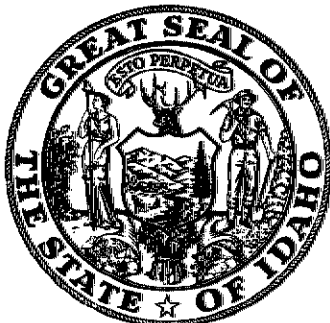

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the undersigned, being the president of Ready, Set, Go, Inc., an Idaho corporation, in order to dissolve said corporation, pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, hereby adopts the following Articles of Dissolution:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Ready, Set, Go, Inc., and its post office address 2247 Spring Mountain Drive, Boise, Idaho 83702.

THIRD: Following the execution of the written consent of the shareholders to dissolve the corporation, the corporation does cause notice of its prospective dissolution to be mailed to each of its known actual or known potential creditors not less than thirty (30) days prior to filing these Articles of Dissolution.


FOURTH: All debts, obligations, and liabilities of the corporation have been paid and discharged or adequate provision has been made therefor.

FIFTH: All the remaining property and assets of the corporation have been distributed among the shareholders in proportion to their respective rights and interests.

SIXTH: There are no suits pending against the corporation in any court.

SEVENTH: The dissolution has received the unanimous written consent of the shareholders.
